**Whereas,** by knowing and understanding and actually using this power, we have the ability to send out a positive ripple that may travel for miles, and;


**Whereas,** no one, no matter how young or how small, is too little to make a difference in our community and our world, and;

**Whereas,** through acts of kindness, we can promote healthy behaviors and positive dynamics within our schools and our community, and;


**Whereas, we seek to stand up to bullying in our schools, workplaces, and community, and;**
