Whereas, our school system recognizes gifted education is vital to healthy communities and the successful futures of countless students who require supportive services; and


Whereas, the school system recognizes that gifted students have special needs in the following areas: intellectual, academic, and creativity; and

Whereas, our students, employees, and community appreciate the vital roles played by those individuals who, as local school board members, establish policies to ensure an efficient, effective school system; and


Whereas, school board members serve as voices enabling our community to preserve local management and control of our public schools; and

Whereas, school board members are charged with representing our local education interests at the local, state, and federal levels; and


Whereas, school board members must engage in much professional development training in order to ensure compliance with state and federal law; and
