Dear Second Grade Parents,

We are very happy to welcome your child to Second Grade! It is an exciting year of growth, and we are thrilled to be part of their journey at MKA. We are looking forward to working with you as well, and we are ready to form a strong parent-teacher partnership for a successful year.

As September approaches, we will want to get to know your child before the start of the year. Please look out for an email from your child's teacher in late August. This email will contain a questionnaire with questions regarding details about them as people. We are looking forward to getting to know them better for the start of school.

We will be providing all necessary school supplies; however, the following list contains some items your child will need for their year. **Please label these items** with your child's name so they can be easily identified.

- **Backpack** - Students should plan on bringing a backpack to school. We ask that you do not send backpacks with wheels. Also, please note that students are not permitted to bring locker decorations to school.
- **Reusable water bottle** – This will be kept on your child's desk throughout the year and sent home to be washed every day. We ask that the bottle will sit securely on the student's desk and has a tight seal to avoid spills.
- **Code of Attire** - Second graders wear the MKA Primary School code of attire daily. Sneakers are required as part of the code of attire. - **Change of clothes** - Please send in an extra pair of labeled, code of attire clothes in a sealed, plastic bag for your child to have handy in the class. There are some days when students will get wet and/or gritty as they explore in the Outdoor Classroom.

- **Family photo** – Teachers will display each child’s family photo in the classroom as part of our yearlong study of communities as well as part of a way to share each student’s identity.

We appreciate the time you are taking to help us get off to a great start and look forward to working with all of your children this year! Enjoy these remaining days of summer with your family!
