Overview: Students will spend their time immersed in learning and serving in Downtown Cincinnati. We will partner with local agencies to learn about the needs present in our community and then go out and serve sharing the love of Jesus with people in need.

 - *Learn God's heart for suffering people and reflect on how God wants to use each of us to serve His people.*

Each day we will meet at school at 8:00am and then travel to ministries in Cincinnati. Each day students will participate in activities that build their understanding and empathy for God's people and then lead us in service activities each day. We will volunteer in a variety of local organizations, including a food pantry, and a homeless shelter. We will also spend a day working with students with multiple disabilities.
