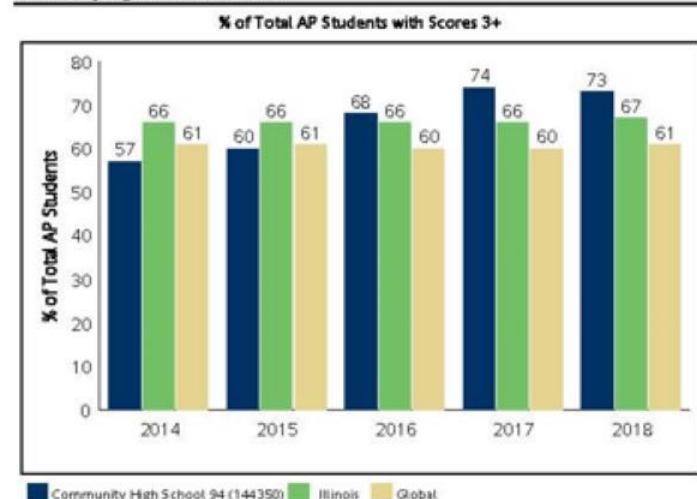
AP® Five-Year School Score Summary (2018)

"Success" on an AP Exam is defined as an exam score of 3 or higher, which represents the score point that research finds predictive of college success and college graduation. These findings have held consistent across the decades. One example of such a study comes from the National Center for Educational Accountability, which found that an AP Exam score, and a score of 3 or higher in particular, is a strong predictor of a student's ability to persist in college and earn a bachelor's degree.

The data in this report differs from other College Board reports, such as *The AP Cohort Data Report*, which tracks exams taken by seniors throughout their time in high school (cohort-based) and includes public school data only.

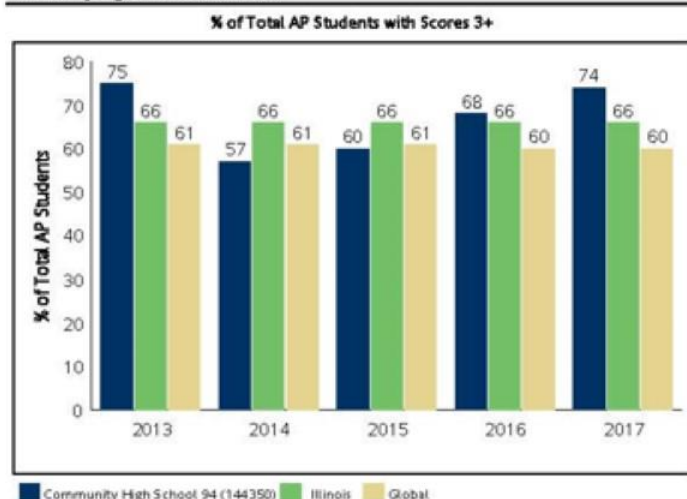

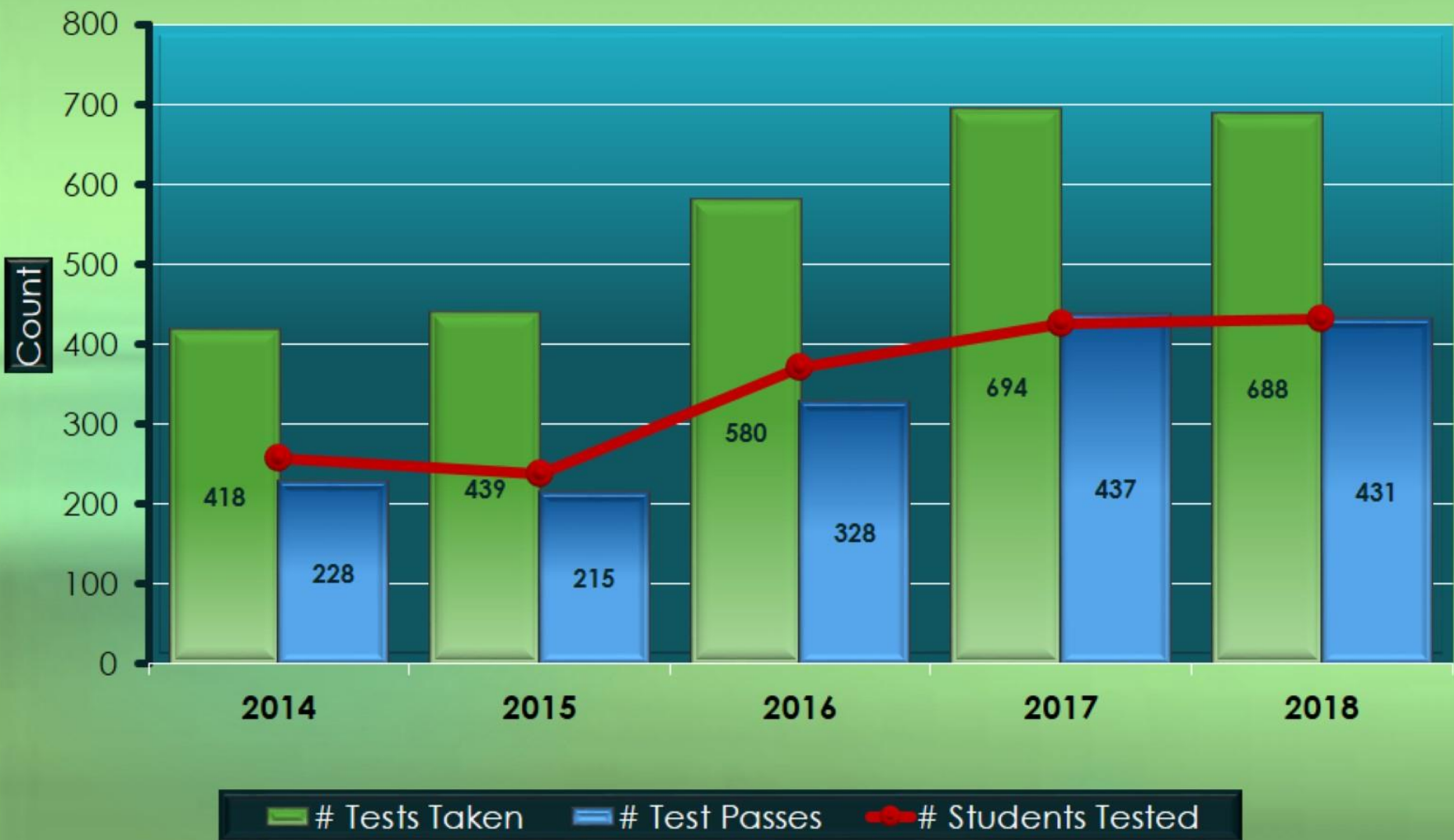
"Success" on an AP Exam is defined as an exam score of 3 or higher, which represents the score point that research finds predictive of college success and college graduation. These findings have held consistent across the decades. One example of such a study comes from the National Center for Educational Accountability, which found that an AP Exam score, and a score of 3 or higher in particular, is a strong predictor of a student's ability to persist in college and earn a bachelor's degree.

by School Year 2014-2018

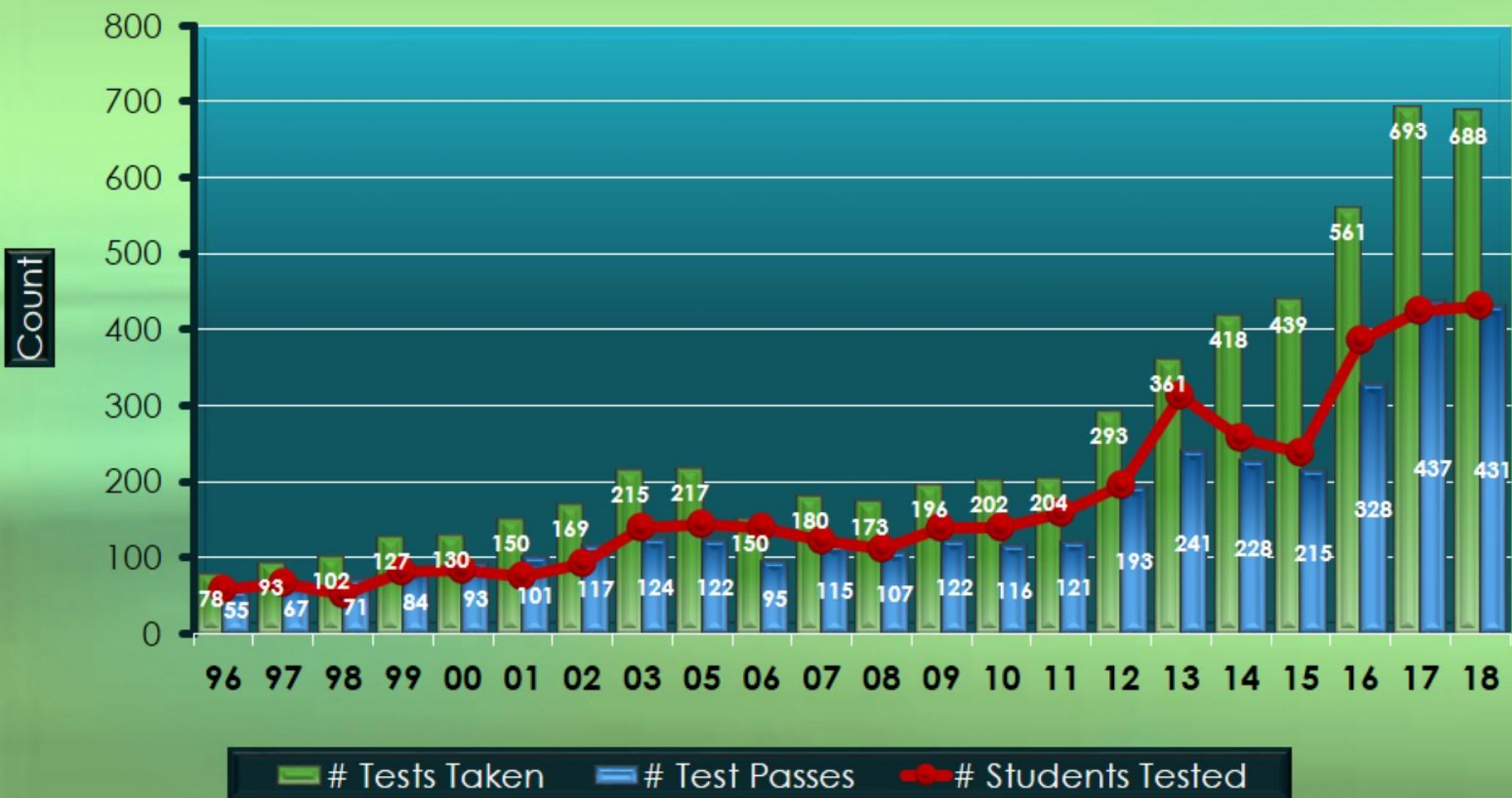

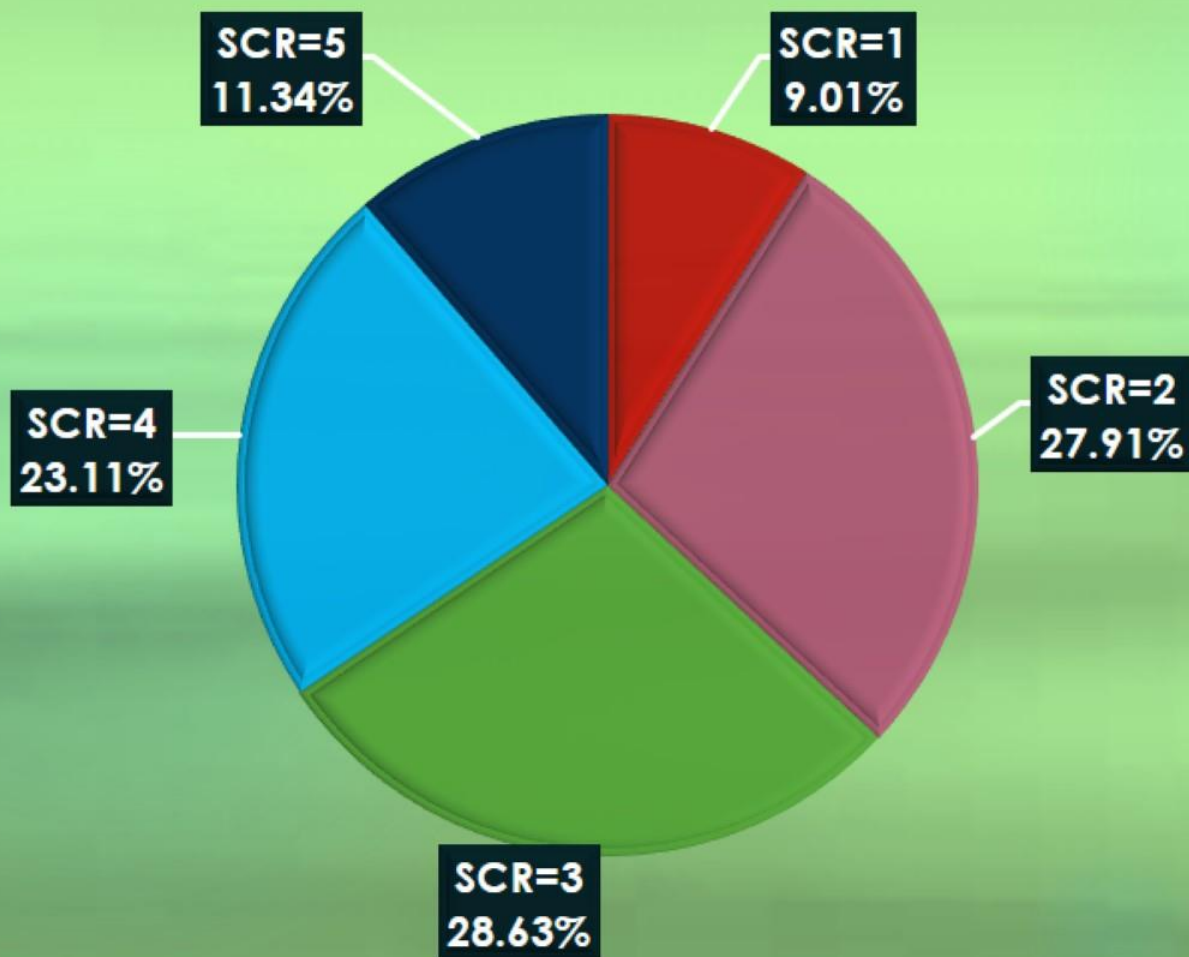

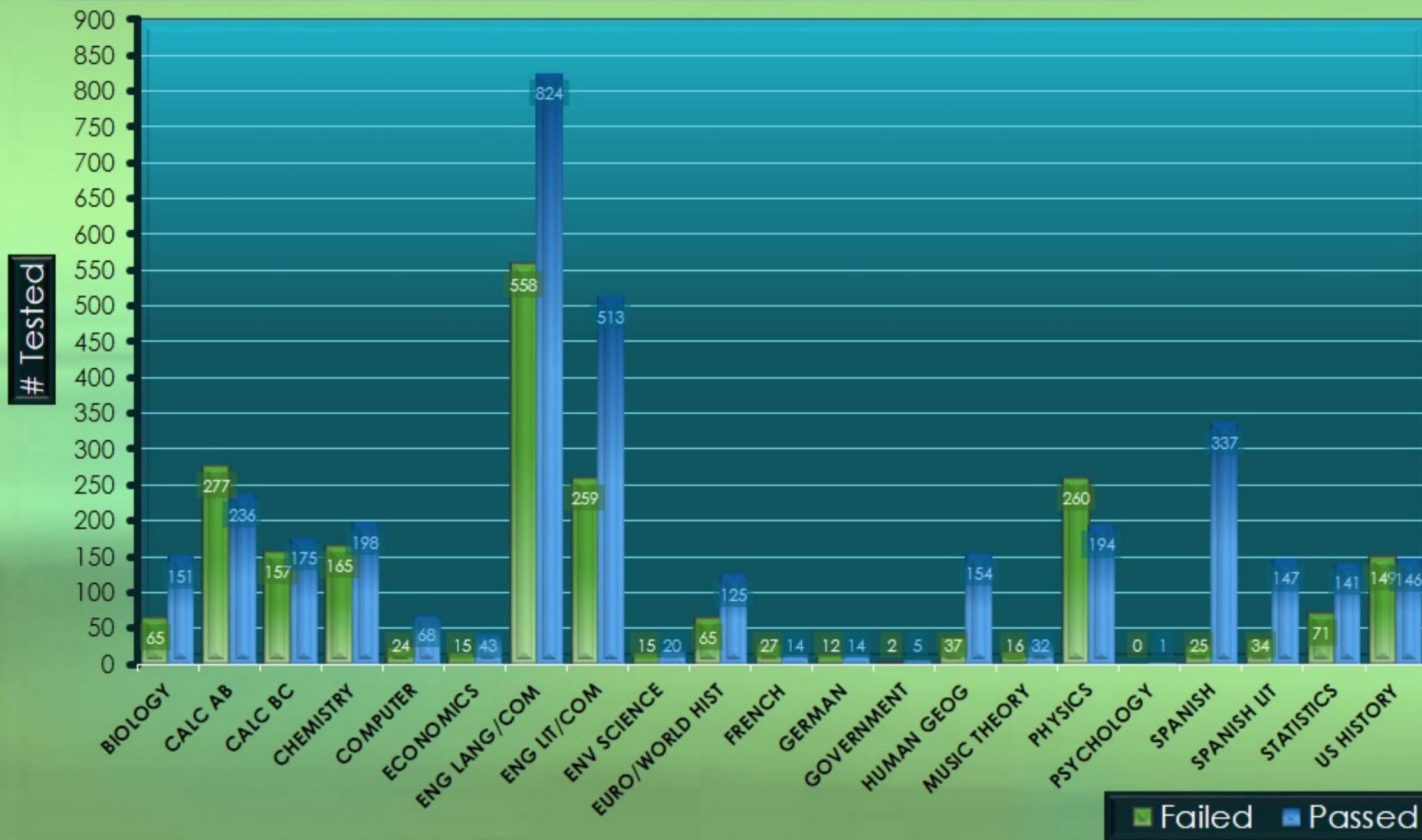

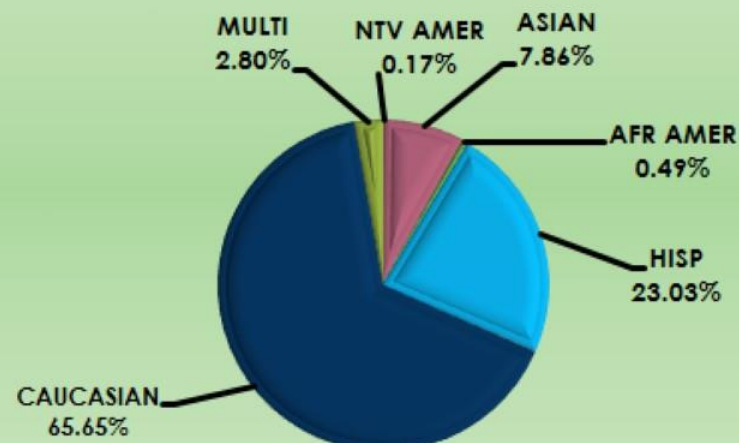

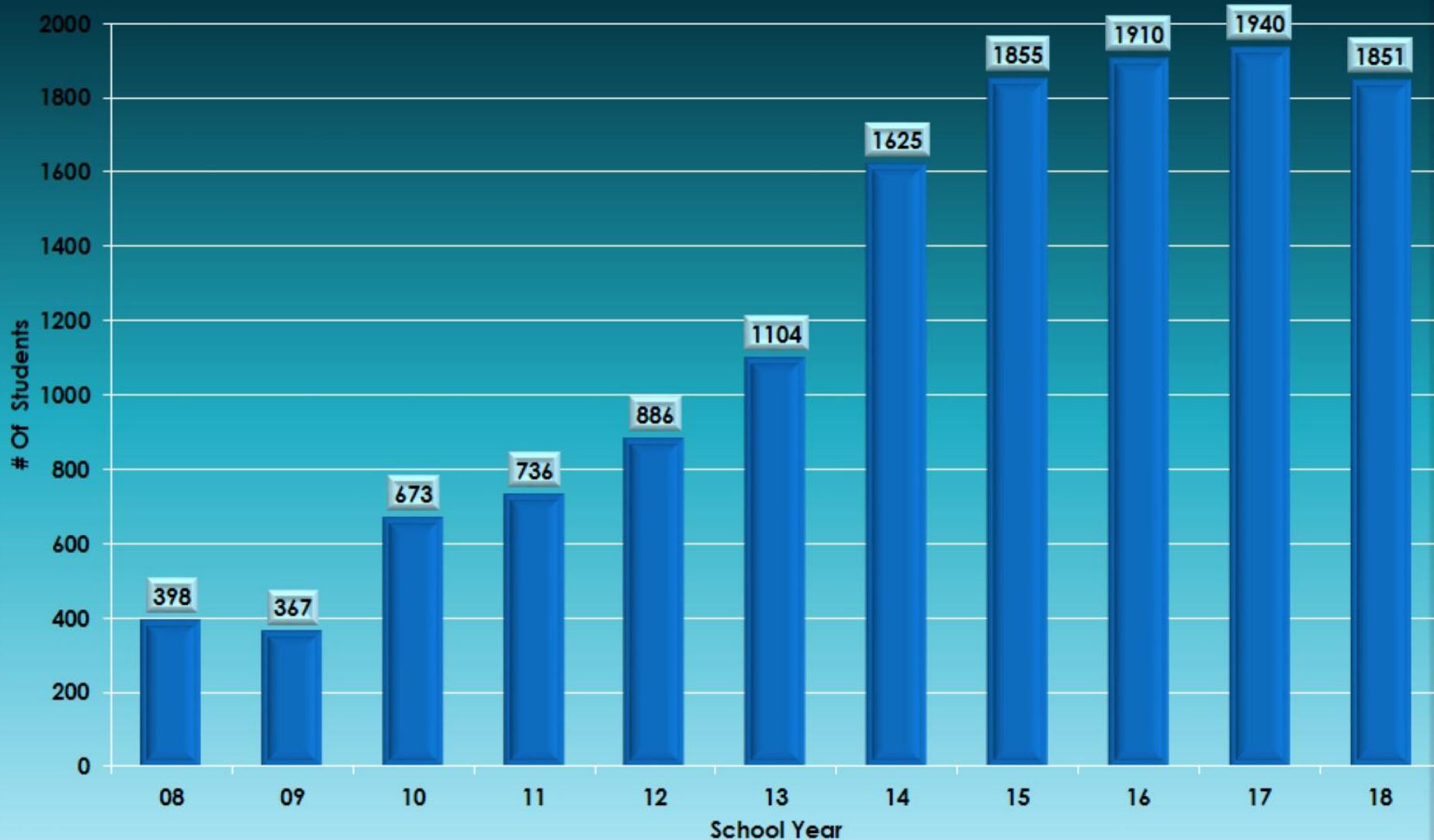

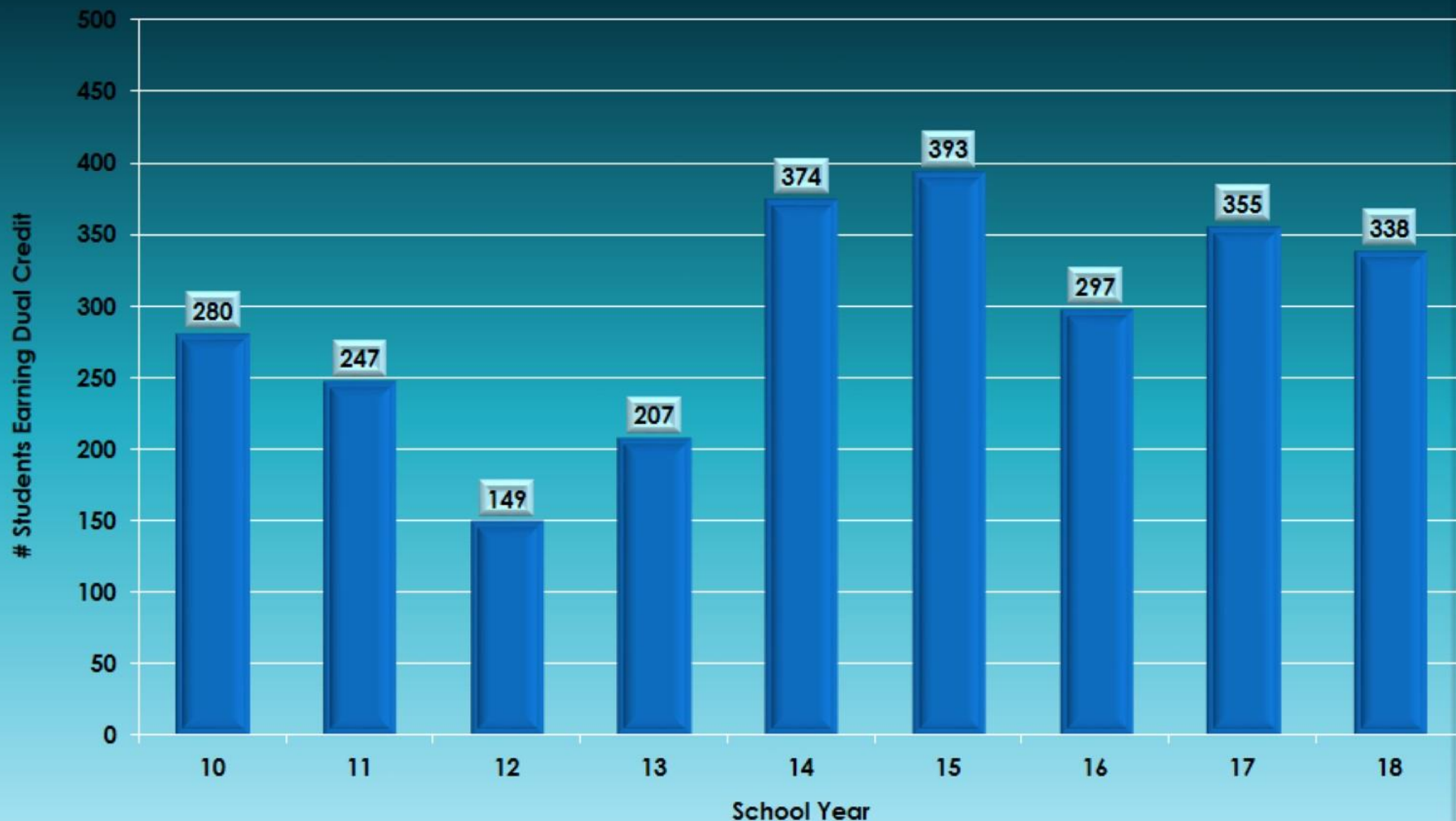

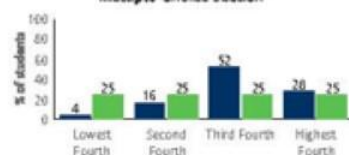

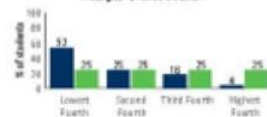

Overall Score Distributions



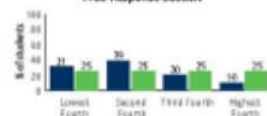

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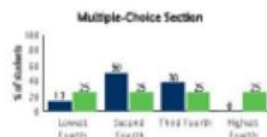
Music Theory Aural and Non-Aural Subscores: Two subscores are reported for the aural and non-aural portions of the exam. The aural component includes multiple-choice questions related to recorded music (examples, two-voice duet-style questions, two-voice triad-style questions, and two-voice style questions). The non-aural component includes multiple-choice questions requiring some score analysis and others not related to recorded music. It also includes free-response questions calling for realization of a figured bass, realization of a chord progression from Roman numerals and composition of a brief but forthright melody. The subscores help music departments make appropriate decisions about credit placement when they offer separate courses for writing theory and aural skills. Although each college sets its own credit placement policy for AP courses, we include a table for credit placement along with our study, as colleges are considered along with the comparison, and that the college sets the credit placement policy for students seeking general transfer credit.

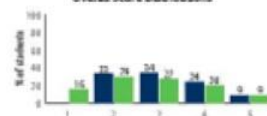

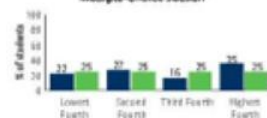

Overall Score Distributions



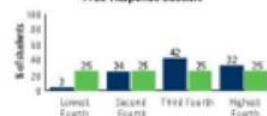
