Girls track competed at their 3A Sectional Championship last night at Metea Valley HS. Junior Kali Waller took her record breaking career to the next level qualifying in 4 events which no girl or boy from West Chicago has ever done before. Kali won sectional titles in the 100 and long jump and set a new school record in the 200m Dash. Adeline Draper added a sectional championship in the 100 hurdles and qualified in the 300 hurdles as well. Gia Deconcilis and Anna Lesny joined Adeline and Kali on the 4x100 relay breaking their own school record running the 400 meter race in 49.08 seconds. Not qualifying for state but moving up the all-time West Chicago ranks were Maggie White in the pole vault, just missing a new school record, as well as Helena Jankowska in the 800. Emily Nosky finished her career strong by smashing the 6 minute mile barrier for the first time running 5:46. Congrats to all who competed and wish Anna, Gia, Kali, and Adeline luck as they prepare for the state meet next week at Eastern Illinois University.

Boys track competed in the UEC conference championship on Thursday night. Big congratulations go out to conference medalists Jaden Bates (100 200), Mason Williams (200), and Matt Dewees (300 Hurdles) as well as sophomore Judah McLean in the 1600. The boys will travel to Batavia on Thursday night for their sectional championship, wish them luck.

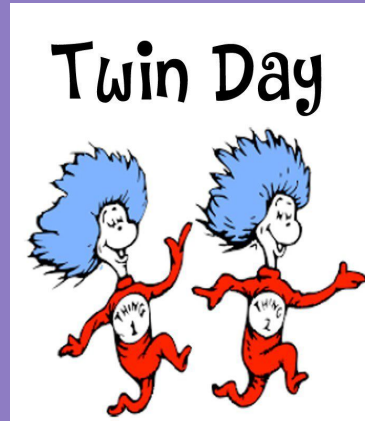

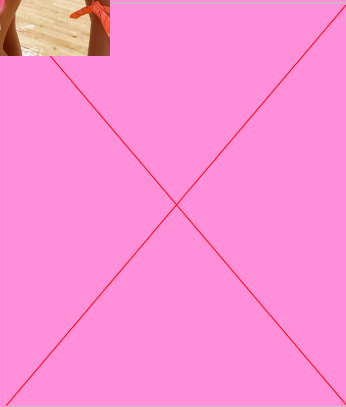
