Hey Anime Nation, hope to see you this Wednesday so we can say goodbye to our wonderful Seniors and of course watch some awesome Anime.

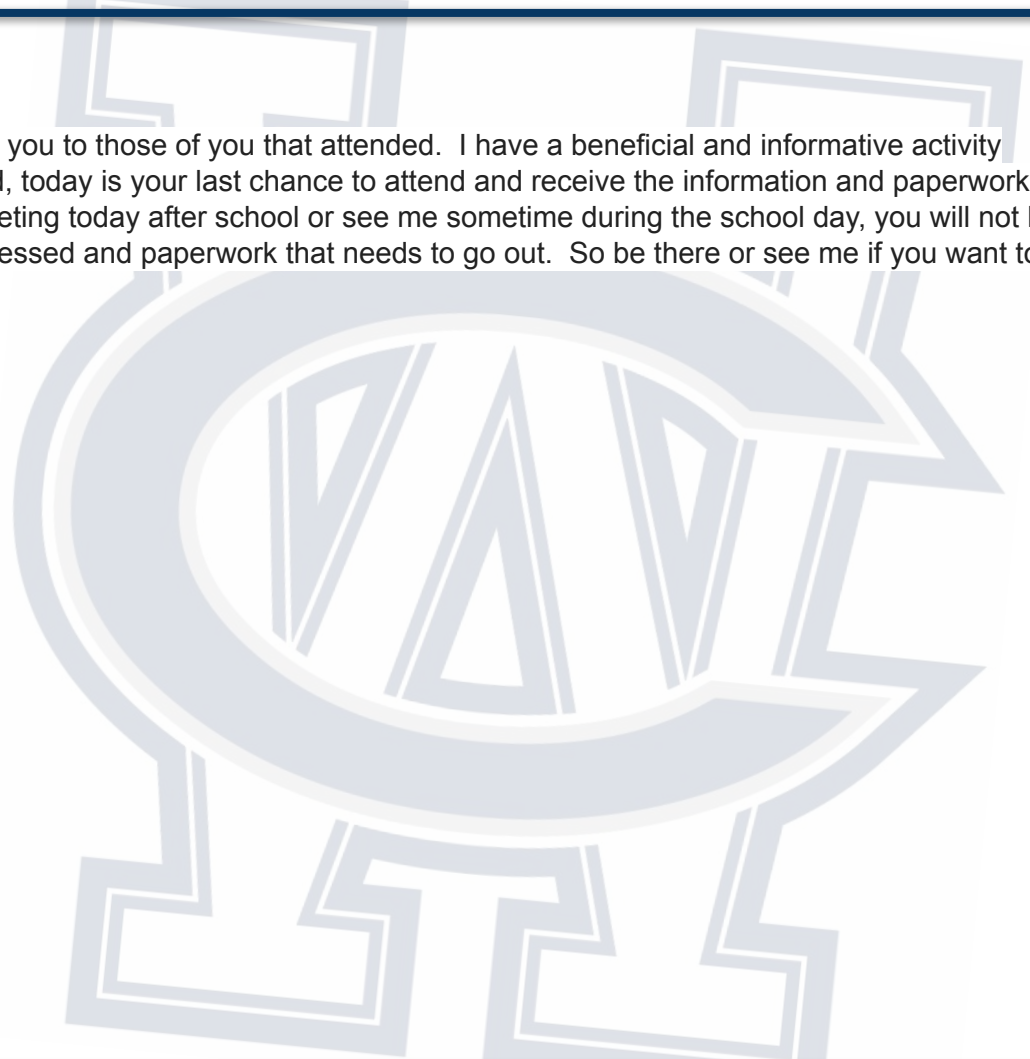
