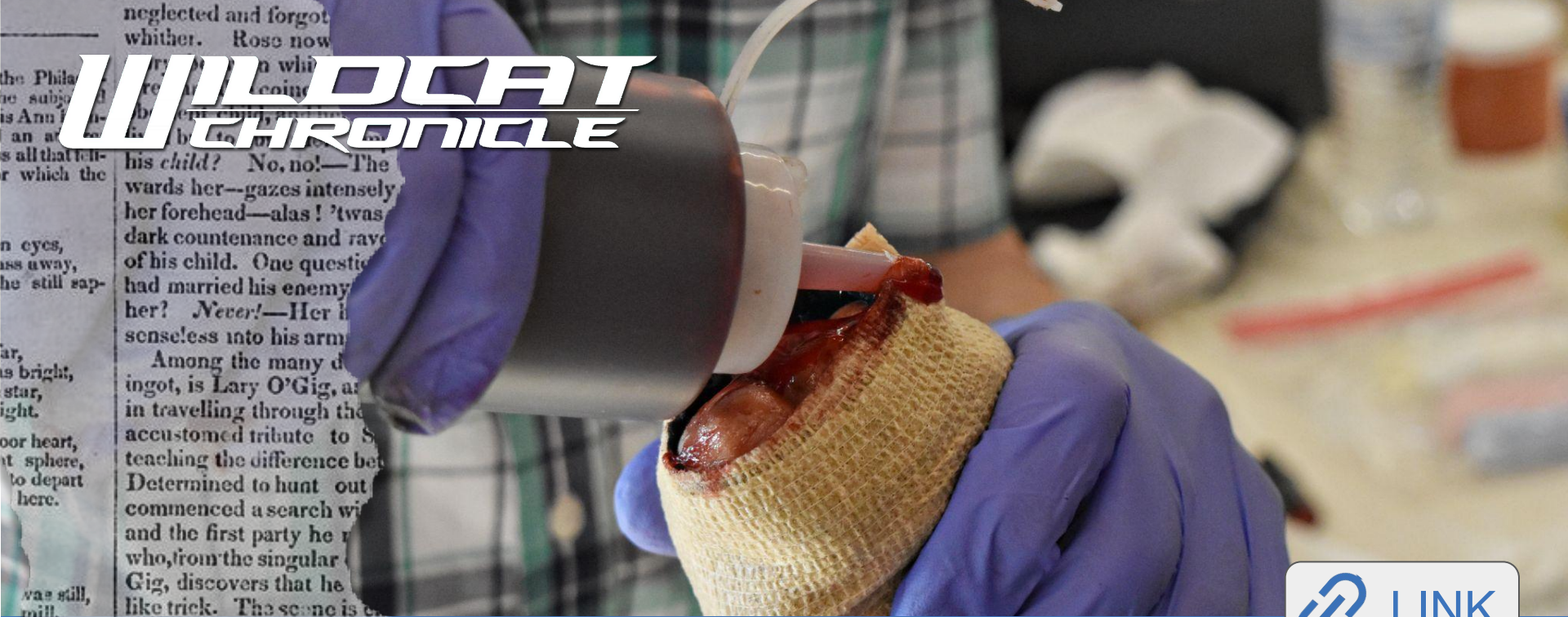

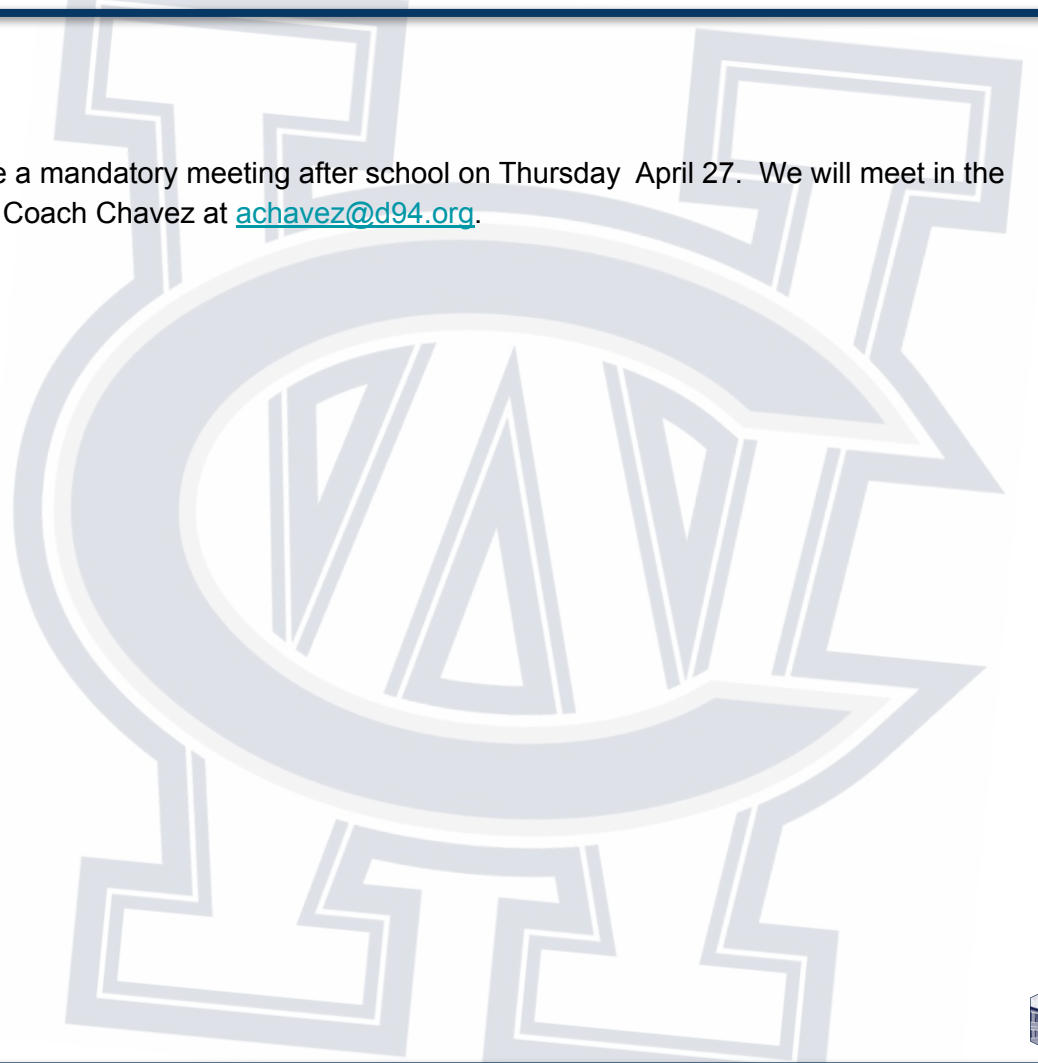
PREVIOUS ANNOUNCEMENTS

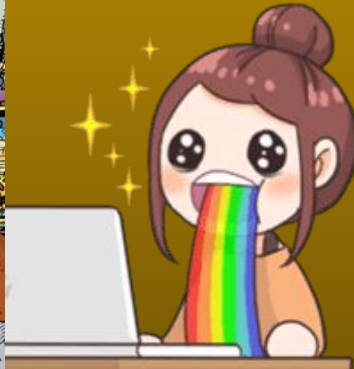
