SAT	SAT is a State of Illinois mandated test, administered to 11 <sup>th</sup> grade students. The SAT measures the skills needed to be career and college ready and provides students with a college reportable score. STAR Enterprise assessments	STAR Enterprise assessments are a district administered test designed to help teachers assess students quickly, accurately, and efficiently. STAR provides teachers with reliable and valid data. The STAR assessments are administered to 9 <sup>th</sup> , 10 <sup>th</sup> and 11 <sup>th</sup> grade students in English and Mathematics. Advanced Placement (AP)	Advanced Placement tests are administered to students at the end of an AP course. The AP test assesses students understanding of the material covered in the AP exam.
