VI. Administrative Discussion Items, Presentations, and Updates

- B. Board of Education Special Meeting for Building Tours on May 15, starting at 11:30 a.m.:** The Wadsworth City School District will hold a special meeting on Monday, May 15, starting at 11:30 a.m., at Central Intermediate School. While the detailed purpose statement for the meeting will be released closer to May 15, the Board intends to re-institute their building tours by starting at Central Intermediate School, then moving to Wadsworth High School and finishing the day at the Charles R. Parsons Administration Building. A portion of the Charles R. Parsons Administration Building is anticipated to be the temporary home to the Grizzly Academy (K-4 alternative school) during the 2023-2024 school year.
- C. Academic Council World Languages Recommendations:** The Academic Council met on Tuesday, April 2,5 to finalize their recommendations to the Board of Education on how to expand our world languages program K-12, per our [Strategic Plan 2021-2025](#). You can view the recommendations by clicking [here](#).
- D. K-12 School Safety Grant Program:** We were recently notified that we were awarded a total of \$70,000.00 from the state of Ohio through the K-12 School Safety Grant Program. The money was allocated to Central Intermediate School (\$25,000.00) and Wadsworth High School (\$45,000.00). The money will be used to buy safety-related items for each building as part of our school safety plan.
- E. Intermediate School Building Project Update:** We continue to work through the process to mitigate the wetland area on the construction site. We are working with the Army Corp of Engineers and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency through the process. We anticipate finishing the wetland work and receiving the necessary permits in June. At that point, we will need to have a bat study completed on the trees that remain in the wetland and required setback area, as we are in Indiana bat season and trees cannot be removed without the said study being completed. Provided the study finds no Indiana bats, we anticipate ground breaking occurring sometime between late June and mid July. The construction process is expected to last up to twenty-four (24) months. Our goal remains to open the 2025-2026 school year in the new intermediate school building.
- F. Tennis Court Project Update:** Due to ongoing water infiltration issues at the current location of the tennis courts (south side of our high school) and our inability to resolve the issues over the last five (5) years after working with many consultants and trying many different solutions, the Board made a decision to relocate the tennis courts to the area north of the Middle School in 2022. After the bidding process, Mr. Excavator was awarded the project. The

project began last month, and it is anticipated that the new courts will be completed by the end of May.

- 5. Summit Educational Service Center Proposal:** The Summit Educational Service Center proposal being recommended for approval will provide for an additional five (5) days of audiology services, based upon the needs of students, per their individual education programs (IEPs).
- 6. Julian & Grube Compilation Proposal:** The Julian & Grube Compilation Proposal being recommended for approval will allow Julian & Grube to continue to prepare our basic financial statements (BFS) in compliance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP) for the fiscal year that ended June 30, 2022.

Tentative Wadsworth High School 2023 Graduation Roster:** The tentative Wadsworth High School 2023 graduation roster being recommended for approval represents all students who are currently eligible for graduation. As commencement occurs on May 21, 2023, the final list of graduates will be recommended to the board of education at a Board meeting after commencement.

The original agreement was approved by the Board of Education on April 10, 2023. The revision removes some language that is problematic for the court.
- 13. Wadsworth Educational Support Personnel Association OEA/NEA (WESPA) Memorandum of Understanding (MOU):** The MOU between WESPA and the Wadsworth City School District Board of Education being recommended for approval details the pay structure for a special education aide or special education attendant who drives their student to/from a job site, in addition to working with their student in their role as aide or attendant.
- 14. Revised Job Descriptions:** The job descriptions being recommended for approval align the special education aide and special education attendant job responsibilities with the memorandum of understanding detailed in #13 above.
- 16. Surveillance 247 Service Plan:** The Surveillance 247 Service Plan for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 being recommended for approval is for the cameras in our school buses and vehicles.
- 17. Nathan Nawalaniec Performance Contract:** The Performance Contract between Nathan Nawalaniec and the Wadsworth City School District Board of Education, effective April 21, 2023, being recommended for approval is for a performance held at Isham Elementary School on Monday, May 1, 2023.
- 18. Tipping Point Management Company, LLC:** The Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement between Tipping Point Management Company, LLC and the Wadsworth City School District Board of Education being recommended for approval will allow Tipping Point Management Company, LLC to work with our Board of Education to

consider future options for the current Central Intermediate School, per the [CIS Committee's recommendations](#) to the Board in 2017.

19. **Nightfall Entertainment, LLC:** The Nightfall Entertainment, LLC Business Agreement between Nightfall Entertainment, LLC and the Wadsworth City School District Board of Education being recommended for approval is for DJ and other related services for senior prom on May 13, 2023.
20. **Galaxy Restaurant & Banquet Center Agreement:** The Agreement between the Galaxy Restaurant & Banquet Center and the Wadsworth City School District Board of Education being recommended for approval is for the 2024 junior banquet.
21. **Ramsey Education Privacy Policy, Terms of Service and Amendments:** The Ramsey Education Privacy Policy, Terms of Service and Amendments being recommended for approval accompany the textbook adoption approved by the Board of Education on April 10, 2023.
22. **Partner Marketing, LLC Sponsorship Agreement:** The Sponsorship Agreement between Partner Marketing, LLC and the Wadsworth City School District Board of Education for the period of May 9, 2023 through May 8, 2026 being recommended for approval will allow Partner Marketing, LLC to continue to work with us on advertising and sponsorship revenue. We have worked with Partner Marketing, LLC since December of 2016. Currently, Partner Marketing, LLC is helping us transition the advertising and sponsorship at both Art Wright Stadium (scoreboard) and Wadsworth High School (main gym scorers table) from the contract with the PowerAd Company (formerly Side Effects) that ends on June 1, 2023 to our own.
23. **Reduction in Student Instructional Hours (2022-2023 School Year):** The reduction in student instructional hours for the 2022-2023 school year being recommended for approval is necessary to officially adjust the board-approved 2022-2023 school calendar to account for the day without student instruction due to the weather conditions. Even with the reduction in instructional hours, we are well above the minimum number of instructional hours required in a school year by Ohio Revised Code (see chart on the following page). The required hours are as follows:
