**2. Employments**

- a) Halle Baker:** Ms. Baker is being recommended to fill the part-time third grade teaching position at Valley View Elementary School, split with Ms. Kelly Gleason, left open by the transfer of Ms. Hannah Myers to a preschool teaching position that was left open by the resignation of Ms. Kelsey Thomas. Ms. Baker will start at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year.
- b) Meghan Barker:** Ms. Barker is being recommended to fill the full-time teaching position, split between Ms. Petit's first grade classroom and Ms. Schmeltzer's second grade classroom at Isham Elementary School, left open by the transfer of Ms. Caitlyn Sypherd to a first grade teaching position at Isham Elementary School. Ms. Barker will start at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year.
- c) Cindy Beeman:** Ms. Beeman is being recommended to fill the full-time technology teacher position at Wadsworth Middle School that is open due to the transfer of Ms. Elizabeth Davis to the new technology integration specialist position for grades 7-12, starting in the 2023-2024 school year.

provided by Suburban School Transportation Company, Inc. for students whose individual education program (IEP) requires the services during the 2023-2024 school year.
