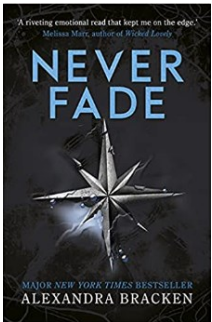

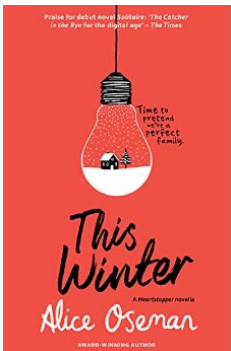
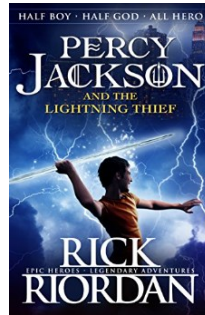


Your favourites from the library:

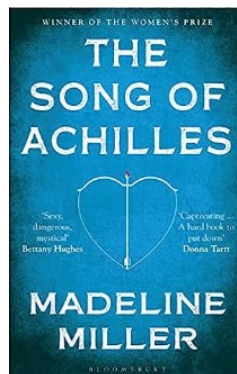


"My favourite book! It is the second book in a series of four. It's a thriller, and a romance, with sad parts. I love it!" NC Year 8

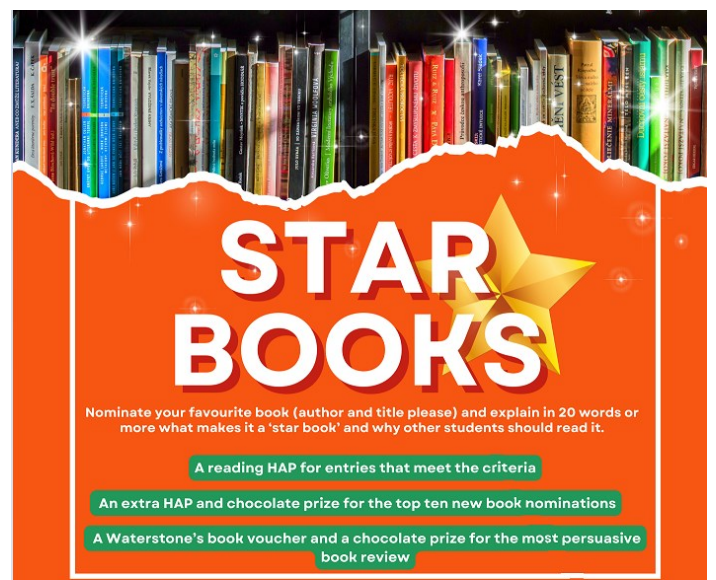
But now there is no water left at all.
