14. Discovery Corners.

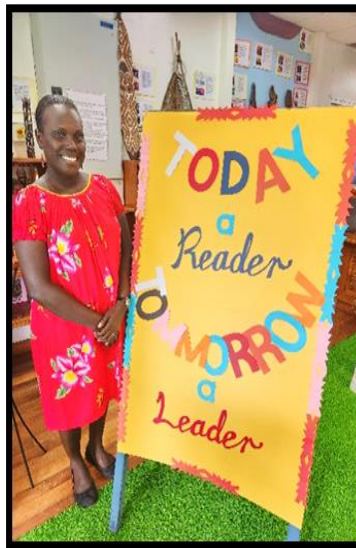
