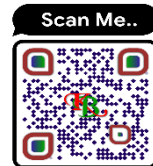

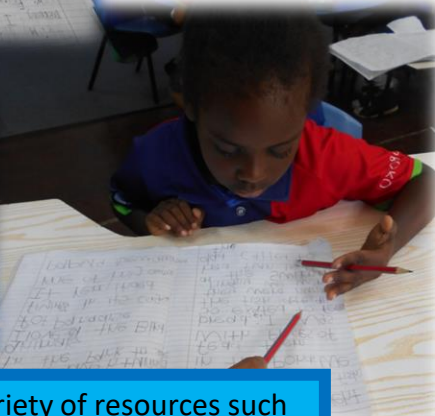
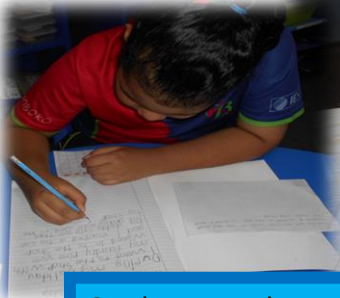

1CB ARTICLE FOR THE INFORMER!**

We have been learning to write a **FACTUAL RECOUNT**. A recount is retelling of series of events in order. Students have learnt the structural and language features of the factual recount. Using the structure and language of a recount, they are able to create a factual recount for themselves of their holidays. First they get to writing their piece of work using a checklist to guide their writing. Next, they edit it using a separate checklist to perfect their piece. Then they re-write their edited piece of work. Finally, they write their final piece of writing.



Mental Starter is a fast recall, rehearse and refine of strategies used to solve problems. The first method in math is Mental Starter whereby the students work out a problem mentally using suitable resources. Here the grade 1 CB students have used a number fan to work out number bonds to 10 by flashing the correcting number that bonds with the number called out by the teacher.



Students used a variety of resources such as ten frames, unifix cubes, number lines, hundred square and knowledge of number facts to efficiently solve problems of counting on and back in tens.



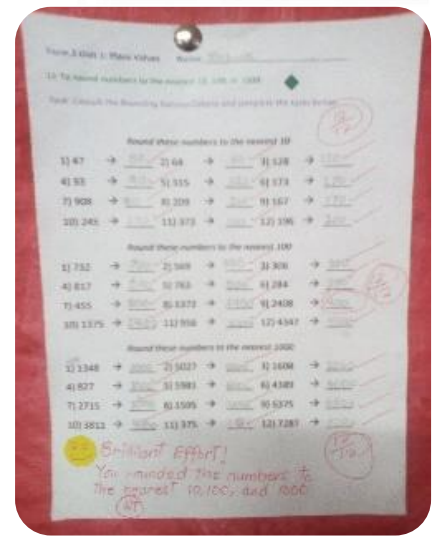
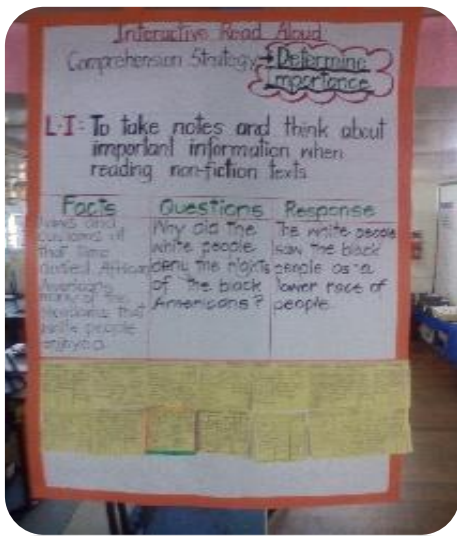
