Counselors will meet with each junior individually. We will cover the following topics during our meetings:

- Review current grades
- Check Social Security number students must have an accurate SS# in the student information system (Infinite Campus) in order to be eligible for any type of state or federal financial aid for college, university or technical college
- Verify that the student's name is spelled correctly in Infinite Campus



- Discuss <u>HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarship</u> requirements
- Review the student's current HOPE GPA
- Discuss <u>HOPE Rigor Requirements</u>
- Review the courses offered at EJCHS that meets the rigor requirements for HOPE
- Discuss registration for the SAT/ACT/Accuplacer or ASVAB
- Discuss the fee waivers for both SAT/ACT



- Review the EJCHS graduation requirements
- Verify that the student's current transcript is accurate
- Verify that the student is registered for all courses needed for graduation in their senior year
- Review post secondary plan
- Student will receive a copy of important information discussed in the meeting
- Verify that the student has created a GAFutures account
