

DRESS CODE POLICY

Stonewall Elementary School

Stonewall Elementary School is an educational facility. Students attending Stonewall will abide by the following dress code so as not to disrupt the learning process.

1. Students may not wear garments with obscenities, vulgarities, profane language, double meaning, alcohol, cigarette, or drug advertisements, ethnically, sexually, or racially offensive stereotypical language or pictures.
2. Students may not wear garments which expose their midriff.
3. Students must wear pants, skirts, and shorts at waist level, and no part of any undergarment may be revealed as a result of fashion or style. Long shirts or sweaters will not alter this requirement.
4. Students may not wear shorts or skirts shorter than the fingertips of the child's extended arm.
5. Students may not wear chains attached to wallets or pants.
6. Students may not wear hats or sunglasses while inside the building except on special days approved by the principal.
7. Students may not wear facial jewelry, except in the ear.
8. Clothing with letters, words, or phrases across the seat may not be worn, except minor manufacturer's logos or trademarks.
9. Students may not wear shoes which contain wheels.
10. Students may not wear tops with spaghetti straps or halter type necks.
11. Interpretation of the Dress Code Policy is at the discretion of the principal.
