Mainstream EAL Program

- English language learners develop their language skills in an immersive English environment with full access to grade-level curriculum
- Support may come from their classroom teacher or EAL teachers working with students in targeted small groups

主流EAL課程

- 主要支援來自他們的班主任或EAL教師在目標小組中的學習

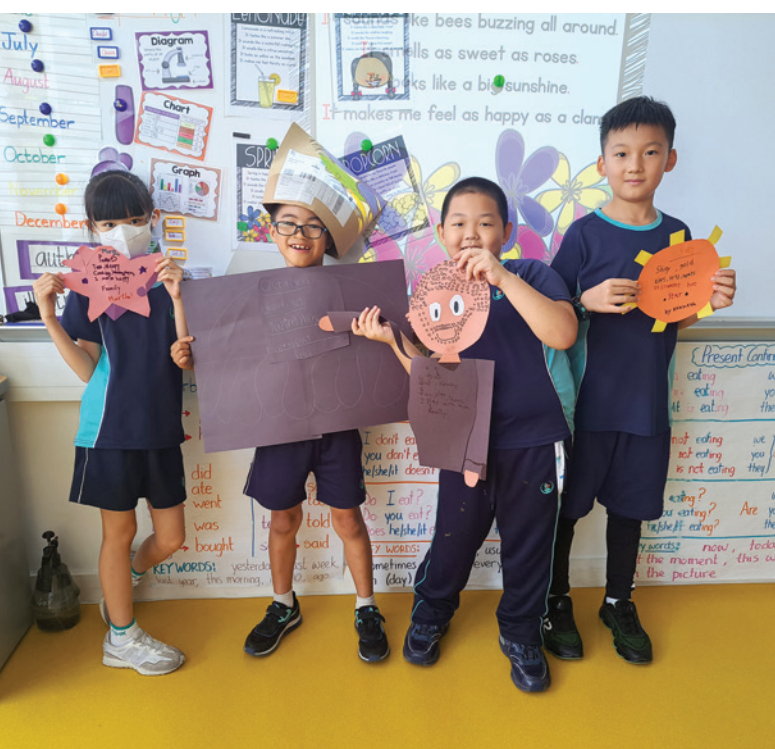


Foundational English Program (Grades 2-5)

- Tailored to students at the Beginning to Developing stages of English proficiency
- Develops students' foundational skills in reading, writing, listening, and speaking
- Provides a separate, supportive, small class environment
- Students integrate daily into specialist classes and activities with their mainstream cohort
- Receive 12 x 40-minute lessons per week in the FEP Classroom
- Spaces for FEP are limited allowing for accelerated acquisition of the language

基礎英語課程 (2-5年級)

- 為處於初級英語水平至發展階段的學生量身定製
- 幫助學生發展閱讀、寫作、聽力與口語方面的基本技能
- 在專屬、充分支援及小班教學環境中學習
- 每天在專屬的時段強化英語學習，同時亦與主流班的學生一起融入活動中學習
- 每週在FEP課堂上接受 12 x 40 分鐘的課程
- 為確保在英語豐富的環境中進行最佳學習，FEP名額是有限的

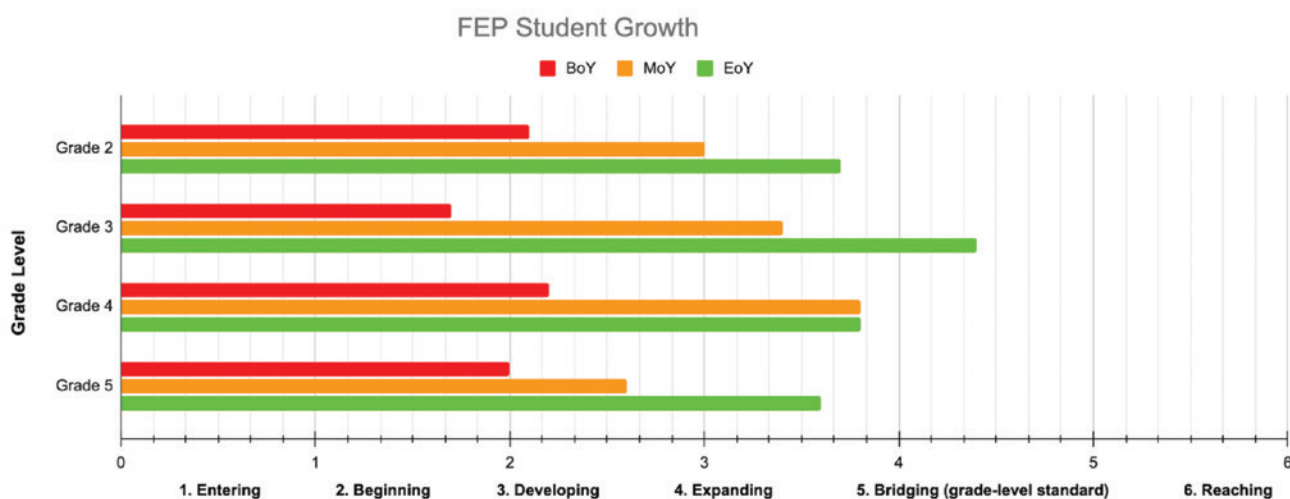


Bridging Program (Grades 6-8)

- Students in Grades 6&7 receive separate instruction during all English Language Arts and Social Studies lessons
- Students in Grade 8 receive separate instruction during all English Language Arts lessons
- Students learn alongside their peers in our mainstream program for all other subjects
- Allows students to more rapidly develop the target language skills to fully access the secondary curriculum and ensure academic success.
- Class size is capped at 12

英語銜接課程 (6-8年級)

- 6年級和7年級的學生會在所有英語語言及社會科學課程中接受獨立的指導
- 8年級的學生會在所有英語語言課程中接受單獨的指導
- 學生在所有其它科目的主流課程中與同齡學生一起學習
- 讓學生更迅速地提高所需的語言能力，幫助學生能力學習中學課程，引領學生邁向成功
- 銜接課程的班級人數上限為 12 人



Placement and Assessment

All programs use an English proficiency assessment aligned with WIDA standards during the Admissions process to place qualifying students in the appropriate program. English proficiency levels are evaluated using a Beginning of Year, Mid-Year and End-of-Year standardized language assessment alongside continuous formative assessment. Students graduate from the program when they have reached a level that will allow them to independently and successfully access the literacy curriculum.

The goal of the Foundational and Bridging Programs is graduation within one semester. However, students who require additional time to meet the program's exit criteria may continue for an extra semester. As these programs are highly intensive, and with limited spaces available, only those applicants that show dedication to their studies and a strong academic record will be considered.

分班與評估

所有英語課程均按照WIDA要求的標準進行一致的評估，以便為學生安排合適程度的課程。我們會在學期初、學期中、學期末進行標準化的語言評估，並持續評估學生的英語水平。當學生的英語水平達到能夠成功地獨立學習語言課程時，他們就會從該課程中「畢業」。

基礎課程與銜接課程的目標是在一個學期內「畢業」（達到相應的英語水平）。然而，如果有些學生需要更多時間來達到該課程的「畢業」標準，可以額外進行多一個學期的英語輔導課程。由於這些課程為高度密集的速成語言課程，而且名額有限，因此勤奮學習及學術紀錄良好的申請學生會優先取錄。
