Socio Emotional Education would be part of the model, but says they have not received anything. Advisory period only happens sometimes. How do you plan to make that happen?

Amirah Holloway- High School MPTCS Teacher. Substitute issue in schools. No protocol or procedures of what is going on in schools. Some subs just sit in the room and do not do anything. We need a protocol to resolve this issue. Investment in teachers: A lot of growth but has to find her own PD that comes out of her pocket. Wants more opportunities.

Karen Edge: News coverage about sale and bond requirements. What is happening with the gym? Pastor Rouse explained the difference between Friend and MPTCS. There are two boards. Nothing Illegal has been done. Charter Schools are under attack. MPTCS is specifically under attack.

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Shantay Lewis: PAC Teacher Asking about the nurse.

- 1. Saying one is not enough. SPED under resourced.
- 2. Feels IEP is not being met.
- 3. The assessment and curriculum is half planned.
- 4. The lack of communication is an issue.
- 5.Lack of supervision from recess the kids are getting hurt. Pastor Rouse said the school will have to respond. Principal Steve Sandor is addressing the issue. Acknowledged that SPED is an issue and they are working to address it. He has been in contact with Ms. Weidman and they have . Pastor Rouse has confirmed law says for Nurse is 1 nurse for every 550 students.

Karen Campos: Speaking for a student: Wants to know the new changes how will they impact. C. Hines

Yvette Barr: Parent at PAC: Said 1 nurse isn't enough even if it is legal. Her son is diabetic.

Emily Atkins: Feel saying the same thing over and over again. Very bitter about Mr. Gregory. When times get tough he leaves. Can't see the grades on the portal. Wants to know why board members are here Dominique Lee said he has reached out to this parent and they have had conversations. They have resolved her issues. Most parents speaking are those from Select Campus.

Shaniqua Nesmith- Parent . Says there doesn't seem to be teamwork within the administration. Feels parents have not been included in the communication. Needs consistency. Feels the issues are the same as last year. Still has to be strong curriculum. Her son is a sophomore and has not had a meeting to speak about college. Pastor Rouse committed that we will lay everything out at the next board meeting. Asked parents to come back.

Tiffany Williams - STEAM Academy . Her concern is the curriculum and the math. She believes there needs to be more training for parents on curriculum. They have a training tomorrow at STEAM. Thinks there needs to be training for the nurses.

Nkita Cuppy- Parent . Son with respiratory problems and complaining about the nurse. Child is always sick because the other children come to school sick. Wants to make sure students are vaccinated. 8th grade science . Never has any homework or a grade for marking period 1. They are not allowed to use the chromebooks.

Maria Parelis- Teacher at PAC. Thank you to board for allowing students to go see Hamilton. BRICK is adapting new ideas into the curriculum. Curriculum is not always perfect but we have seen growth in the new curriculum. Work in progress

Cassandra Johnson- PAC Teacher Speaking about the nurse issue. Might be because there are 4 PREK classes in the building. Sees growth within her students

Talisha Johnson- Parent PAC: If school is in crisis how long do we need to wait for a new plan. How do we keep the momentum of her child's learning. Give him homework. Even though her child is above grade level she wants more. Wants to know the math scores. Jessica Alfaro teacher at PAC said she never received homework. She has to make her own.

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Gwen King - Parent. Concerned about the incident and fighting in the school. Likes the after school math and english help they provide the students

Ronald Drumman- PAC Parent- Question about follow up about Ms. Johnson. Worried about the math. Would like another math teacher for the 3rd grade. Wants his daughter to be challenged.

Tamia Rouse - Wants to acknowledge the teachers of MPTCS. Very satisfied with the teachers. We have to work together.

Ms. Stokes - First Grade Teacher at PAC: Math teachers who are responsible to the ELA her SGO is combined with ELA and she can never meet with her. Everytime she is supposed to meet the ELA teacher gets pulled into another meeting. Need more unity at PAC. One building two principals but feels divided.

Rhonda Ammilian- STEAM Parent: Student has an IEP. Misses Ms. Johnson. Having trouble with curriculum. Teacher told her in January that her child will not make it to the 4th grade.

Finance Committee Report:

- We have revised the approved budget based off the October 15th enrollment numbers. We sat with school administrators to trim from their school budgets. We have cut a substantial amount from Central Office. We were able to cut \$1.5 million without touching staff or programming.
- We may need further cooperation from Friends to ensure we have closed the remaining \$1,000,000 budget deficit. We will have to do a rent reduction.
- As you are aware, we currently have a \$500,000 line of credit for MPTCS. We have met with bankers and supplied them with all the required financial information to obtain the \$1,000,000 line of credit. Preliminary we have been told we are approved for the \$1,000,000 but we have not received it in writing yet.
- We have completed our social impact report which is a requirement from our lenders for the bond for the High School. We have compiled financial, parental involvement, and high school activity information for the report. The requirement has been satisfied.
- Clarification of CMO financial relationship
 - The CMO is taking administrative costs from MPTCS. Departments and resources such as the Finance, HR, and Operations are being managed at the CMO level so the schools can focus on instruction.
 - $\circ\quad$ We are in the process of assembling oher costs the CMO has paid on behalf of MPTCS
 - such costs include, but are not limited to, training of principals, instructional materials, and programs the CMO has paid for.
 - o We will assemble the total of what it comes to and present it to the board.
- The CMO has also committed \$600,000 to MPTCS. We have already spent about half of that commitment. This does not include the admin costs and we still have to determine how the rest will come in.
