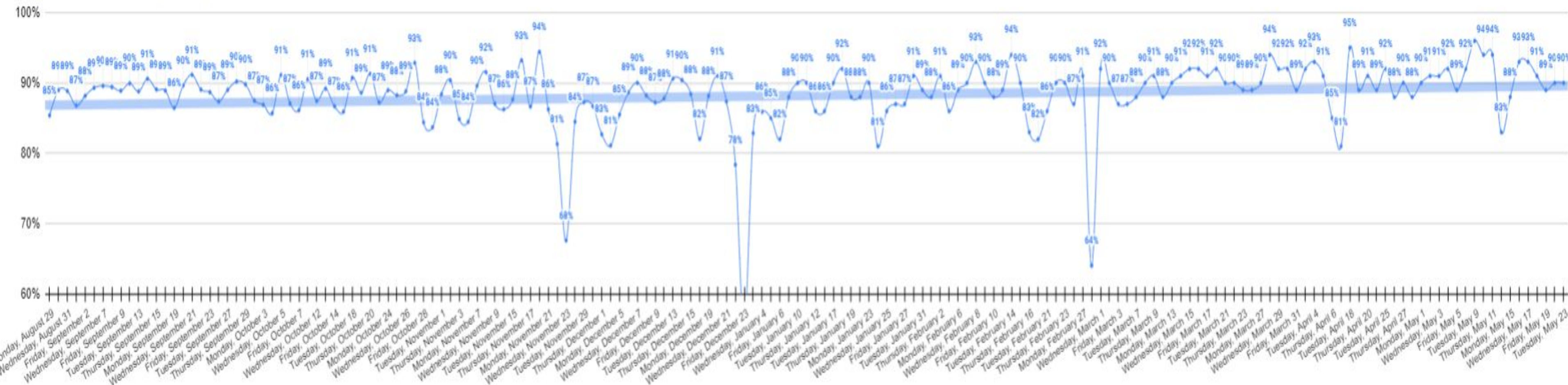

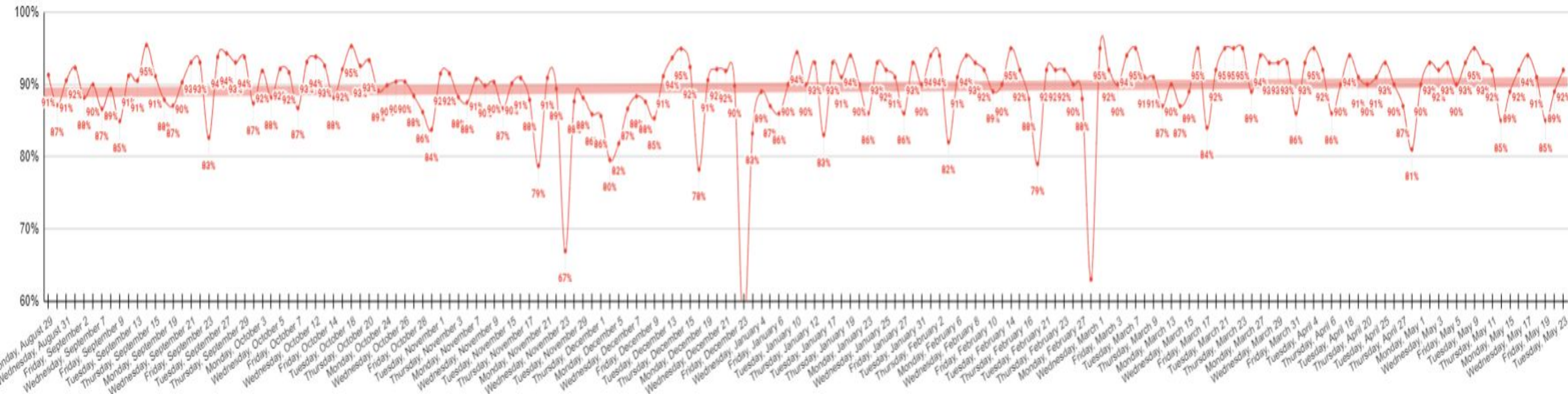

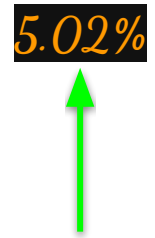

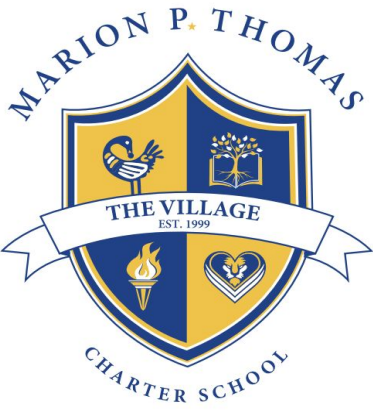
PAC ACADEMY - Average Daily Attendance

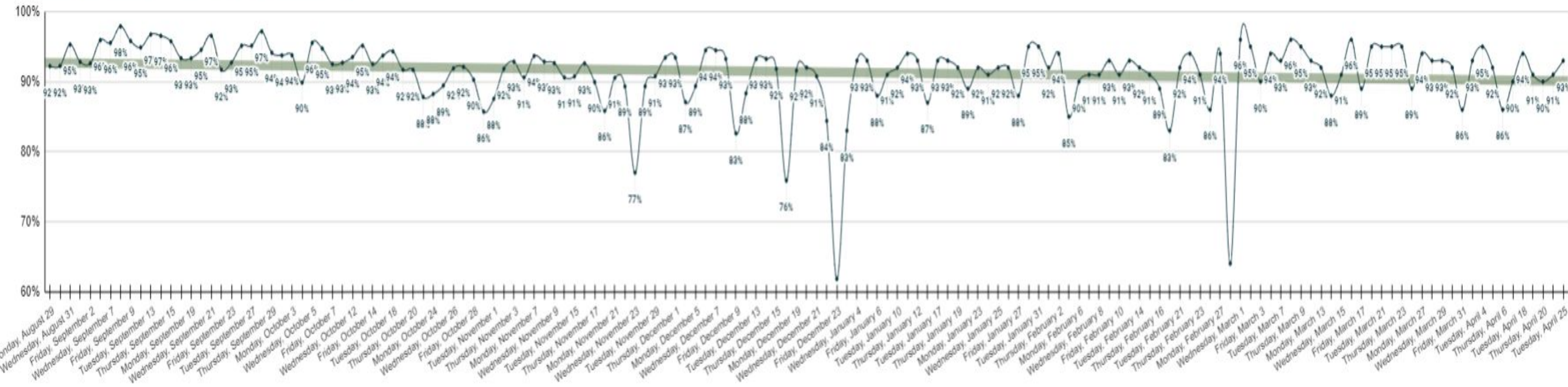

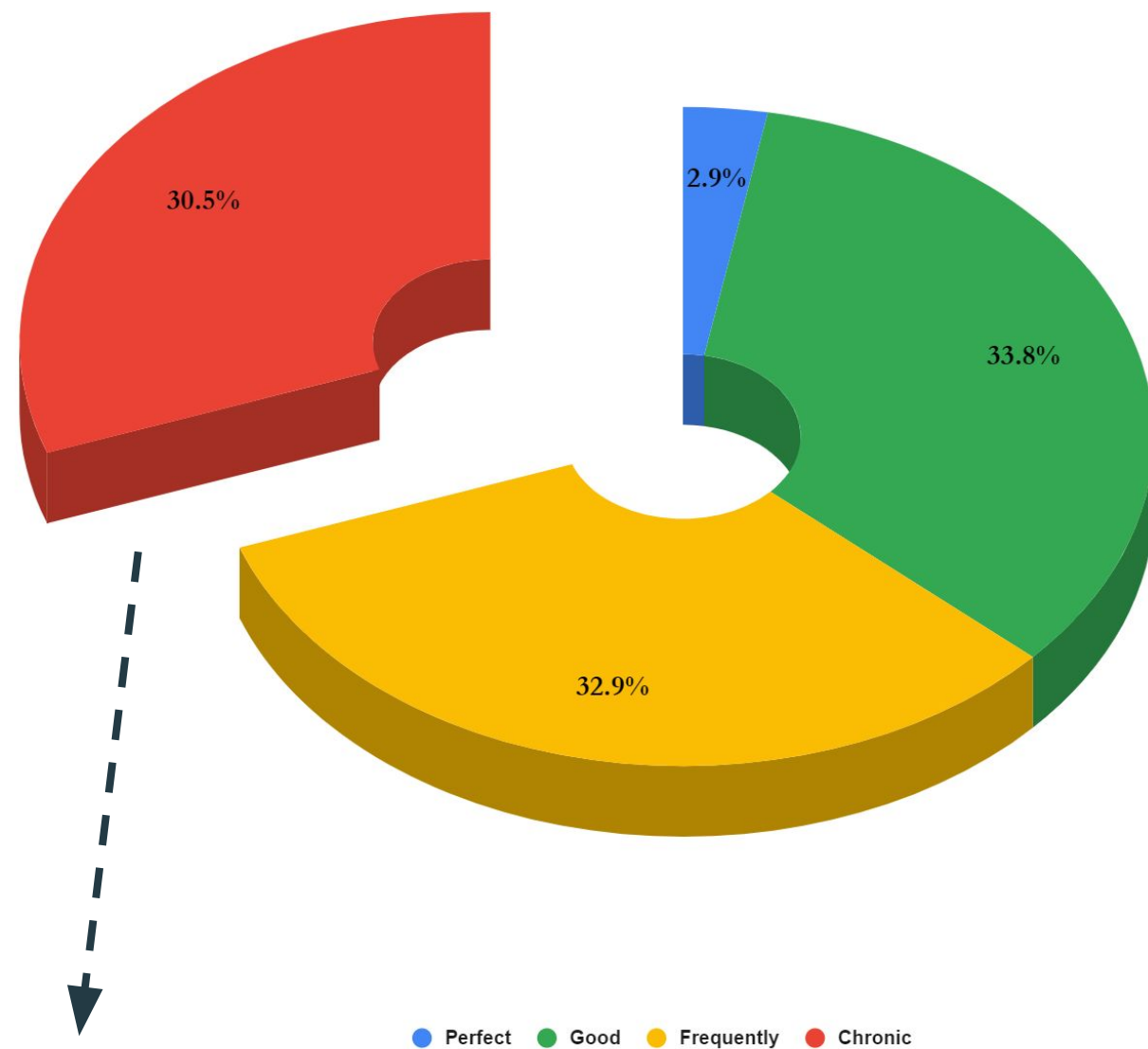
