★ ***NWEA Map Assessment***

- Key priority for this year to measure student progress which has been critical in the absence of state standardized tests—we will continue to use this assessment over time.
- NWEA MAP Assessment - Administered in the fall, winter, and spring in grades K-11
- Based on the initial assessment, students are given an individualized growth projection
 - Teachers utilize baseline and mid-year data to tailor instruction



Percentage of Students Meeting Fall-Winter Growth Projection




% of Students Meeting Fall-Winter Growth Projection (Math)


% of Students Meeting Fall-Winter Growth Projection (Reading)


Percentage of Students Projected to be Proficient on NJSLA Math

Percentage of Students Projected to be Proficient on NJSLA ELA



Staffing Updates


- District Hiring Fair was held on April 2nd. We offered on the spot interviews.
 - 50 attendees throughout the morning
 - 7 hire recommendations were submitted from the fair


COVID-19 Updates



Attendance & Enrollment






- Average Daily Attendance (ADA)








- Planning for a successful charter renewal process started on July 1, 2021.
- We have been focusing on the areas outlined with a heavy focus on academics, finance, and governance.
- The renewal process will officially begin in the 2022-2023 SY for an additional 5-year term (23-24 SY thru 27-28 SY)
- To prepare for our upcoming renewal process next fall, we partnered with Mr. Ben Feit. He has extensive experience working with the charter schools. We were awarded a grant from the NJ Children's Foundation to support his work with MPTCS. The key objectives of the partnership include the following:
 - **External Accountability/Authorizer Relations** - Assist with ensuring that we are in compliance with all state assigned requirements and meeting/exceeding our prescribed deadlines
 - **Strategic Planning** - Assisting with the creation of our 5 year plan
 - **Charter Renewal Support** - Project managing the renewal application process and supporting our data dashboard



