1 **CHARACTER EDUCATION** 2 3 ACPS provides, within its existing programs, a character education program in its schools. The 4 purpose of this program is to foster civic virtues and personal character traits so as to improve the learning environment, promote student achievement, reduce disciplinary problems, and 5 develop civic-minded students of high character. The program may be developed in 6 cooperation with students, parents, and the community at large, and shall conform to the 7 following criteria established by the Board of Education. The program must: 8 9 10 • Specify those character traits to be taught, selecting from those which are common to diverse social, cultural, and religious groups. Specific character traits emphasized may 11 include trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship; 12 13 Address the inappropriateness of bullying as defined in Va. Code § 22.1-276.01; 14 • 15 Be implemented at the elementary and secondary levels; 16 • 17 Complement the state Standards of Learning, be interwoven into existing curricula, • 18 and be taught primarily by example, illustration, and participation. Classroom 19 instruction may also be used to supplement the program; 20 21 Provide for relevant professional development and adequate resources; and 22 • 23 Include a method for program evaluation. 24 • 25 26 Character education shall educate students regarding those core civic values and virtues which are efficacious to civilized society and are common to the diverse social, cultural, and religious 27 groups of the Commonwealth. It shall not include indoctrination in any particular religious or 28 29 political belief. Consistent with this purpose, ACPS may teach Virginia's civic values, which are the principles articulated in the Bill of Rights (Article I) of the Constitution of Virginia and the 30 ideals reflected in the seal of the Commonwealth, as described in Va.
