Leaving campus for lunch is a unique privilege afforded to students of Seabreeze High School. With privilege comes responsibility. Please reinforce with your students the importance of being safe, courteous, and accountable. All students that drive off campus for lunch are expected to drive safely and slowly, obey all traffic signs, wear their seatbelts, keep their audio systems turned down, use good judgment and be back on campus on time. Students are NOT allowed to transport a student off campus who is not eligible for off-campus lunch privilege.

**Juniors and Seniors (ONLY)** are allowed to go off campus during lunch.

To qualify for an off-campus ID Juniors and Seniors need to:

- Have earned a 2.5 GPA or higher.
- Have no obligations.
- Submit a consent form signed by a parent/guardian and on file at the school.
- Purchase an off-campus Lunch ID card for the **2023-2024** school year.

With your help, we can ensure a safe environment at Seabreeze High School.

If your child has their privilege suspended or revoked for one of the above reasons, NO REFUNDS.
