11		Students with disabilities who meet the eligibility criteria established by state law or				
L2		VBOE regulations may be eligible for LAVC as credit accommodations as established in				
L3		the student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Section 504 plan. In addition to				
14		the content areas listed above, the School Board may also award verified credits toward a				
L5		standard diploma in reading and writing to students with disabilities at any point after the				
16		student's eighth-grade year as credit accommodations for the standard diploma.

19		Special Permission Locally-Awarded Verified Credit Accommodations (SPLAVC-A),

24		LAVC determinations are made by review panels appointed for individual schools or				
25		groups of schools. They consider evidence of a student's achievement of adequate

29		(SOL) test; and				
30		• Scores within a 375-399 scale score range on any administration of the Standards				
31		of Learning (SOL) test after taking the test at least twice.
