Letters of Recommendations:

You can ask teachers, counselor, advisors, and coaches to write you letters of recommendation. Provided the teachers with a resume. Ask them to keep them an electronic copy (in case you they have to upload it, or they can tweak it to a scholarship letter later in the year). Forewarn teachers if they are going to receive an email requesting a letter of recommendation from an application website like the Common Application.
