



Dear Rising Seventh Grade Parents,

We want to remind you that all students entering the seventh grade must have a **Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) immunization before the start of the 2023/2024 school year**. Your child will be prohibited from attending school until proof of immunization or exemption is received.

**All students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade in a Florida school MUST submit an updated Florida Certificate of Immunization (DH 680 form) before starting the first day of school. Please have all records returned to school by July 31** (please disregard if you have already submitted a vaccine exemption form to the school).

If your child has already received their Tdap vaccine, you will just need to provide us with an updated DH 680 form before the start of the upcoming school year.
