Scholarships will be made available to High School Graduating Seniors who have the following qualifications:

Qualifications:

- 1. Are enrolled as full-time students and must be planning to attend a two or four year college or university.**
- 2. Excel in their studies and must have at least a 3.0 GPA.**
- 3. Require financial assistance to enable such individual to meet the expense of higher education in pursuit of an academic degree in wildlife conservations, enforcement or management disciplines. (Example. Biologist, game warden, wildlife preservation, etc.)**
- 4. Must be available for an interview with organization scholarship committee.**

The scholarship committee will consider the following attributes of each applicant:

- 1. Work ethic and attitude.**
- 2. Desire to participate in the Educational Foundations targeted disciplines.**
- 3. GPA and class rank.**
- 4. Financial resources**
- 5. Interview**

The scholarship committee will award the grant in order of preference, to:

- 1. Active members and their families,**
- 2. Residents of DeWitt County, or**
- 3. Residents of counties adjoining DeWitt.**
