## John Trott Memorial Scholarship Requirements

The John Trott Memorial Scholarship Fund has been established to benefit Texas High School Graduates who will be attending Texas A&M University seeking a degree in Education.

Applicants must be a resident of Texas and an incoming freshman who has applied and been accepted at Texas A&M University in College Station, Texas.

Scholarships will be primarily awarded to applicants with parents or grandparents that are "members" of Hochheim Prairie Insurance. The committee may choose to award scholarships to applicants who do not meet the membership heritage as determined necessary.

Scholarship recipients are to study in the College of Education. If it is the opinion of the scholarship committee that there is more money than applicants for the College of Education, then students pursuing other disciplines may be selected.

Selection of the recipient will be based on financial need, scholastic achievements, leadership, and scholastic potential.

The applicant's high school transcript and SAT or ACT score should accompany the application.

A typewritten (double-spaced) essay, not to exceed two pages, on "Why I Want to Attend Texas A&M University & Pursue a Degree in Education" is required of each applicant. If pursuing a degree in a discipline other than education, the essay should be tailored to explain your degree of choice.
