Pre-Kindergarten

- Standard size Backpack
- Lunchbox
- 2 composition books
- One plastic pocket folder with prongs
- 1" white binder
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 pack of Play-doh
- 1 Watercolor paint set
- 2 glue sticks
- Change of clothes for emergencies (pants, short sleeve shirt, underwear, socks) Please put emergency clothes in a plastic bag.

Kindergarten

- 3 plastic folders (2 pocket with prongs) 1 Blue, 1 Green, 1 Red
- 1 pair kid scissors
- 4 black fine tip dry erase markers
- 24 #2 pencils
- 1 box tissues
- 4 large pink erasers

Some of the supplies may need to be replenished throughout the year. There is no need to individually label items. Please label lunch boxes, backpacks, and clothing (jackets, hats, gloves, etc.). Send in a change of clothes in a gallon size baggie to keep on hand for emergencies.

First grade

- 5 plastic folders with pockets – Red, Yellow, Orange, Green and Blue (without prongs)
- 1 plastic school box (about 5x8)
- 2 dozen #2 pencils (all wood), sharpened
- 2 boxes of crayons (24 in a box)
- 24 glue sticks
- 1 pair of kid scissors
- 4 large pink erasers
- 2 high-liters
- 1 pair of Headphones
- 1 pack low odor dry erase markers (BLACK ONLY)
- 2 primary composition books (1/2 picture, ½ lines with dotted center line)
- 3 primary composition books (no picture, all lines with dotted center line)

Some of the supplies may need to be replenished throughout the year. Students will leave these supplies in school unless specified by the teacher. Please label everything your child brings to school to insure he/she has his/her own belongings. Please see that your child has these supplies in school every day.

Second grade

- 1 RED plastic pocket folder
- 3 boxes of crayons (16 count)
- 4 composition books
- 4 plastic folders with 2 pockets (blue, red, green, yellow)
- 2 pencil cases, fabric, 3 hole with grommets
- 1 dozen #2 pencils (all wood), SHARPENED
- 1 pair student scissors
- 12 glue sticks
- 2 large pink erasers
- 3 – 4 pack of black, thin, EXPO dry erase markers

Donations are appreciated:

- 2-3 family size boxes of tissues (These will be shared by all throughout the year.)
- 2 containers or boxes of infant wipes
- Plastic zipper baggies (quart and gallon size)
- 1 pack of white cardstock
- 1 pack of THIN and THICK Crayola washable markers

Some of the supplies may need to be replenished throughout the year. There is no need to individually label the school supplies listed above. However, it would be helpful to label your child's lunch box and backpack.

Third grade

- 2 Dozen #2 pencils (all wood), sharpened (Ticonderoga brand if possible)
- 1 Box of Crayons (24 box)
- 1 Color variety 6 pack Highlighters
- 2 Large pink erasers
- 3 Composition books – wide-rule
- 1 Pack filler paper, wide rule
- 1 pair kid scissors
- 20 Glue sticks
- 3 Folders, plastic with 2 pockets and prongs in blue, red, green
- 2 packs 3"x3" post-its

- 1 pack of wide-tip washable markers
- 1 2-count pack of black low-odor wide tip dry erase markers
- 1 pair of small over the ear headphones
- 1 small wireless mouse controller (for use with classroom laptop)

- 1 pair kid scissors
- Headphones or earbuds (we need them for the streambooks)
- Wireless mouse (optional)
