## STRUCTURE

- Serves students who are looking for an alternative to traditional in-person instruction
- Instruction supervised by certified teachers
- Admission based upon available space and the requirements listed in this brochure
- Student enrollment will be transferred from the traditional school to The Academy
- Curriculum will be a blend of online learning platforms and teacher-created instruction.
- Curriculum will include all required Kentucky Academic Standards
- Certified teacher available for in-person support as needed
- Students enrolled at The Academy are not eligible for extracurricular activities such as band, sports, clubs, field trips



## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Access to reliable computer and internet if working from home.
- Ability to check-in with a teacher on a regular basis
- Adult monitoring and support as needed
- Participation in initial meeting with Academy staff and agreement to learning contract
- Previous success in virtual learning or teacher recommendation.

**For high school students:** We have two types of degree programs - Logan County High School Diploma and Logan County Schools Diploma.
