Seabreeze High School believes that all student are responsible for helping maintain a safe orderly environment. The rules and procedures listed below are to ensure that Seabreeze High School Students are prepared for the real world.

- Students must have **no** obligations to be eligible to park on campus.
- Student must have a 2.5 GPA or higher to park on campus.
- **Students are to park in their assigned areas.**
- Parking decals are required to be visible from the lower driver's side front window of the vehicle.
- All vehicles are subject to search.
- Students are **not allowed** to sit in their cars or loiter in the parking lot **at any time.**
- Students needing to access their vehicle during the school day must receive permission.

Violations of the following actions will result in loss of your parking privilege:

- Reckless driving and/or speeding. Maximum speed is 5mph.
- Ten or more tardies in a semester.
- Leaving campus without following school check out procedures.
- Vandalism to school or personal property – reimbursement costs.
- Parking in the faculty or visitors parking.
- Any unauthorized use of your decal
 - Allowing another student to drive another vehicle with your parking decal.
 - Removing a parking decal and placing it on an unregistered vehicle.
 - Parking an unregistered vehicle on campus without notifying administration.
- Any other action that jeopardizes the safety of students and/or staff.

Violations of the following actions will result in loss of parking privilege after one warning:

- Sitting in cars or loitering in parking lots.
- Playing car radio too loudly on campus.
- Parking in non-designated parking areas. For example, on the grass, curb, non-lined pavement or blocking gates or traffic lanes.

The administration of Seabreeze High School may adjust student parking if the need arises.

If an emergency occurs that requires you to drive another vehicle to school, please report the vehicle change to Mrs. Peckham in Attendance, immediately upon your arrival at school to receive a temporary parking pass.

Any unauthorized use of your parking decal will result in parking privileges being suspended or revoked.

The administration of Seabreeze High School takes every precaution necessary to make sure your vehicles are safe. However, Seabreeze does not assume responsibility for your vehicle or other personal items while on campus. When your vehicle is on campus; it is to be locked. It would also be wise to keep your valuables out of sight.

To all individuals entering school premises: A principal or designee may search, including but not limited to, your person, briefcase, book bag, purse, packages, locker, storage area and vehicle upon reasonable suspicion of prohibited or illegally possessed substances or objects.
