- ★ ASPIRE will have both in-person and online options for 9th-12th grade. Online students will have the option to take electives in-person.
- ★ Douglas Nevada Online will be a 6-8th grade online school.
- ★ ASPIRE will be offering dual credit (will count as high school and elective college credit) courses from Western Nevada College taught by adjunct professors. The courses will have a fee, but students will be able to earn 1.0 high school credit instead of the usual .5 credit per semester.
- ★ We are offering three WNC courses in the fall to both online and in-person students at ASPIRE Academy: CRJ Introduction to the Administration of Justice, PEX 169 Yoga, and ART 100 Visual Foundations.
- ★ Online students in 9-12th grade will also have the ability to attend elective courses like Multi-Media (1st class in a three year program to earn a certificate) and Physical Education.
- ★ 9-12th grade ASPIRE Academy students will also have access to some new Career Technology Education courses by Edgenuity like: Introduction to STEM, Introduction to Careers in Education and Training, Sustainable Service Management for Hospitality and Tourism, and Web Development in the 21st Century.
- ★ Students will also have an opportunity to complete a 90 hour COE Internship with DCSD working in grounds to earn elective credits.
- ★ Students will take a Focus class where they will have the opportunity to earn .5 of an elective credit per semester. This will allow all online students the opportunity to earn 7 credits per year instead of 6 credits per year.
