

Student Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

The safety of our students is of the utmost importance. Arrival and dismissal are very busy times for every member of our school. Increased traffic volume and weather conditions can cause an even greater deal of congestion within our school ground lanes. Please follow all arrival and dismissal procedures accordingly. If your child is a "walker," parking is prohibited on our school grounds, as this creates congestion and safety concerns. In addition, please do not block the box upon entering school by car. This creates congestion and delays our busses from entering the grounds. When entering school by vehicle, please follow the correct lane (by grade level) and reduce speed to ensure everyone's safety. In addition, if you are a walker, please be sure to utilize any one of our cross-walks. Please do not walk through the parking lot areas of the grounds. We thank you for your cooperation to make our arrival and dismissal procedures safe and efficient for all of our students and their families. Please refer to the student handbook (beginning on page #5), which outlines our arrival and dismissal procedures in depth.

Additional Arrival/Dismissal Reminders:

Family Drivers:

All cars waiting on Mountain Avenue must have their directional signals on and remain in their vehicles.

Please "Do Not Block the Box/Driveway" upon entering school property.

Please remain in your vehicle during pick-up and drop-off. Do not leave your vehicle unattended.

Please drive slowly at 5 mph.

Please stop at each crosswalk and check for families crossing for their safety/well-being. Walkers always have the right of way.

Please stop your vehicle (and look both ways) when you approach a STOP SIGN (unless directed otherwise).

Please park only in designated parking spots, NOT on the loop/traveling lanes.

Please do not block residential driveways.

Family Walkers:

Please keep your children close to you as you walk around the school property, especially in the parking lot and by the arrival and dismissal locations.

Please remember to use the designated crosswalks on school property. Parents must accompany their children when using crosswalks. Do not walk between vehicles, as this creates a safety concern for you and your family and others.

Emergency Closings

If you have any questions regarding school closing or delayed opening, please call the school closing hotline number 973-376-1025 and press 8. This information is updated regularly on questionable weather days. You will still receive automated calls.

Walton School's Student "Call for Safety" Absence Line

If your child will not be in school or will be late please call the "Call for Safety Line" at 973-376-1025 ext. 2650. You may leave a voice message the night of and/or in the morning on the day of prior to the start of school if your child is going to be out. When your child is going to be late please remember they are marked absent until they enter the building. The office staff will change the absence once the student is signed in. Please do not use email as a form of calling your child out from school.

Please remind your child that if they are missing any personal belongings to ask his/her teacher for assistance to the lost and found, which is located in our main office hallway wing.

School Nurse Happenings

Stay in the shade whenever possible especially during mid-day when the sun rays are the strongest. Drink plenty of water even if you are swimming! If you must be in the sun, cover up with light clothing, a hat, and sunglasses. Apply sunscreen 30 minutes before entering the sun and reapply often. Monitor for signs of heat exhaustion to treat it before it progresses to heat stroke, which is a medical emergency.
