



## Spring 2023 MAP Report

Each school year AAC uses the MAP tests from NWEA to help determine our levels in Reading and Math compared to the US norm. Millions of students all over the world take MAP tests, so we have a large number of students to compare our data to and make judgments as to our progress. The tests are challenging and untimed, and they are adjusted according to the performance of each child. AAC administers the test at the beginning and end of each school year. Below are the results.

### Summary/Analysis

The results are still not where we need to be, although they have shown improvement. Our goal is to get each class above the US norms, and we are not there yet. The middle school is especially lagging in their MAP performance. Our academic leadership team has already met and reviewed the results, and we have plans in place to increase our instructional efficacy at all levels. This will include more accountability for teachers to meet targets, increased expectations on students, a few added courses that will increase basic skills and improved resources to improve performance. The school is confident that we will continue to grow and reach the levels we aspire to.

PLEASE NOTE-these testing cohorts are not 100% consistent. New students are included in the 2023 results who were not at AAC the previous year, and therefore are not included in the 2022 data. It is likely that these new students generally score lower, as their first year is focused on bringing their English levels up to par.
