

**McPherson Magnet School – Uniform Policy
2022-2023**

Uniform Tops	Polo Shirts ONLY (No T-Shirts)	Sport Gray, Light Blue or Navy	All Polo Shirts must have a McPherson LOGO from Kustom Imprints or PLAIN SOLID gray, light blue, or navy polo shirt. Sport Gray, Light Blue or Navy Polos with LOGO Uniform tops must be size appropriate. Garments which are too tight, too large, revealing, or allow underclothing to show are not allowed.
	Sweatshirts Sweaters Jackets, Raincoats, and Headwear	Gray or Navy No hoods on sweatshirts Gray or Navy	All sweatshirts must have McPherson LOGO from Kustom Imprints or PLAIN SOLID navy blue or gray with no other logos. Sweatshirts and sweaters must be crew neck - NO HOODS allowed on sweatshirts. Sweatshirts/sweaters may NOT have a logo other than McPherson. Sweatshirts must be size appropriate. Middle School PE sweatshirts may only be worn during PE instruction. All jackets must have McPherson LOGO or be PLAIN SOLID navy blue or gray with no other logos. Other raincoats, heavy jackets, and headwear are for cold/rainy weather and may ONLY be worn outside. No LOGOS.
Uniform Bottoms	Long Shorts Skorts Skooters	Navy Blue & Khaki Bottoms Plaid Skort from Kustom Imprints Must be purchased from Uniform Dept.	"Uniform line" bottoms from uniform stores. No jeggings or jeans/denim. Dickies brand shorts with 3" or 5" hem DO NOT meet dress code standards and may not be worn. Garments which are too tight, too large, revealing, or allow underclothing to show are not allowed. Must be loose fitting. Uniform must be size appropriate and worn at the waistline. They must be hemmed and may not have any holes, tears, or split at the seams. All shorts, skorts and skooters should reach mid-thigh, or MUST reach a minimum of one inch from your fingertips. Shorts or skorts shorter than mid-thigh are prohibited. (OUSD #AR5132). Shorts must be hemmed; no frayed or split seams and must be free of holes.
Layering	Uniform layering is allowed for warmth, coverage, and comfort. Undergarments should not be visible below the uniform shirts. Tights and layering shirts must be PLAIN SOLID color. Approved colors for tights are SOLID NAVY, LIGHT BLUE, GRAY, and WHITE ONLY. Tights with prints or patterns or other colors of any kind are not allowed.		
Shoes/NO BOOTS	Shoes must be worn at all times. Shoes should be flat, closed-toe, and without heels or wheels. Shoes should not have slippery soles or come off the student's feet while running or playing. No boots or Ugg-type boots, Crocs, flip flops, sandals, backless shoes, steel toe shoes or platforms. (Rain boots may be worn on rainy days only.)		
Socks	SOCKS MUST BE WORN WITH SHOES; socks must be visible and no longer than knee- high length.		
Caps/Visors/Beanies	No hats or visors allowed. Beanies may be worn outside during cold weather ONLY.		
Belts	Belts may be worn as needed. No chain, studded, or initialed belts are allowed.		
Hair	Hair must be clean and neatly groomed. Hair designs that cause undue attention or distract from the educational environment are not allowed.		
Jewelry/Accessories	Jewelry accessories that are considered dangerous should not be worn. No wallet chains allowed. Students are not permitted to wear "pierced" jewelry anywhere on their face except for their ears.		
PE Clothes - Middle School	Middle School PE clothes may only be worn during PE. They may NOT be worn in lieu of uniforms. PE clothes may not be worn over school uniform, including PE sweatshirts.		
Friday "School Spirit Days"	All Fridays are designated as "School Spirit Days". Any McPherson spirit, team, or activity shirt/sweatshirt may be worn on Fridays ONLY .		
Free Dress & Special Dress Days	Clothing on Free Dress or Spirit Wear days must be appropriate size and length as stated above. No tank tops, spaghetti straps, cut off shirts, or torn clothing. All shorts/skirts should reach mid-thigh, or MUST reach a minimum of one inch from your fingertips. Shorts shorter than mid-thigh are prohibited. Students not adhering to appropriate dress policy on free/special dress days will be sent to the office and required to change clothes. Parents will be contacted to provide change of clothes or student will be given uniform clothes to change into. Students in violation of the dress code may lose the privilege to participate in future free dress days. Students who participate in a nationally recognized youth organization, such as Boy Scouts/ Girl Scouts, shall be allowed to wear organization uniforms on days when the organization has scheduled meetings. (Education code 35183)
