They are members of the English Language Development Design Team. Beth Skelton, an ELD consultant, facilitated this team. The ELD Design Team was tasked with developing an updated ELD district wide plan to meet the specific needs of English Learners and teachers in Garfield RE-2 District, while meeting the state and federal requirement. The proposed ELD Plan was designed to be an integral part of the district’s WHHW Framework. They discussed the recommendations the team provided to Board members.
