

Recognition for Accomplishment

The Board appreciates the diligent efforts made by its members, staff, students and citizen volunteers in achieving the school district's goals and objects. The Board also is mindful that frequently there are exceptional achievements and contributions made by persons representing our schools which favorably reflect on the whole character of the district. These are the people who accept demanding challenges and set new and higher standards of dedication for the rest to follow.

It is the Board's intent to grant official recognition for such outstanding accomplishments on behalf of the district.

Notification of meritorious deeds that qualify for districtwide recognition shall be made to the Board by the superintendent.

A certificate of recognition and gift certificate shall be given to deserving staff members, students, community members and/or others during a public Board meeting. If the person for whom the certificate is to be presented is unable to attend the meeting, the certificate shall be forwarded with an accompanying letter from the Board president.

Other noteworthiness that brings attention to an individual school shall be handled by the administrator involved.
