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**Regulations for Athletic and Activity Ineligibility  
Eugene A. Tighe Middle School**

***All students must be in Good Academic and Good Disciplinary standing as outlined in Policy 6145 and the E.A. Tighe Middle School Code of Infractions and Consequences Regulation 5131.2 in order to participate in extracurricular activities.***

**Fifth-Eighth Grades**

- **Academics:**
  - Clubs, Sports, and Activities: If a student has 2 or more F's, he/she is considered ineligible for participation for the following marking period. The fourth marking period grades may be used to determine ineligibility in the first marking period for the next school year, at the discretion of the principal. This time will be utilized for work completion and additional study opportunity to improve academic standing.
- **Absences/Tardiness:**
  - Clubs, Sports, and Activities: If a student has 10 or more unexcused absences or unexcused late arrivals, he/she may be considered ineligible immediately for participation in any club/sport/activity at the discretion of the Principal in accordance with the school's Discipline Code.
- **Disciplinary Referrals:**
  - Clubs, Sports, and Activities: Refer to consequences related to Activity Restrictions in the school Discipline Code.

**Fifth - Seventh End-of-Year Activities**

- **Academics:**
  - If a student has failed one class for the year, he/she will be required to attend summer school to earn the credits to pass the class.
  - If a student has failed two or more classes for the year, he/she will be retained and will need to repeat his/her current grade.
- **Absences/Tardiness:**
  - Refer to consequences related to Activity Restrictions in the school Discipline Code.
- **Disciplinary Referrals:**
  - Refer to consequences related to Activity Restrictions in the school Discipline Code.

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### Eighth Grade End of Year Activities

- **Academics:**
  - If a student has failed one class for the year, he/she will be required to attend summer school to earn the credits to pass the class. Diploma will be issued after completion of summer school program.
  - If a student has failed two or more classes for the year, he/she will be retained to repeat his/her eighth grade year. He/She will be ineligible for the 8<sup>th</sup> grade dance, the class reward trip, and promotional exercises.
  
- **Absences/Tardiness:**
  - Refer to consequences related to Activity Restrictions in the school Discipline Code.
  
- **Disciplinary Referrals:**
