

## **Copyright Compliance** (Television Programs)

### **Noncommercial and instructional television**

1. School re-recordings may be made only by students, teachers or faculty of an accredited nonprofit educational institution.
2. School re-recordings will be used solely for classroom, auditorium or laboratory exhibition in the course of instruction or related educational activities.
3. School re-recordings will be used only in the educational institution for which made and will not be given, loaned or otherwise made available outside that educational institution.
4. School re-recordings will be maintained for not more than seven days and will be erased or destroyed at that time or sooner, except as authorized by advance written notice.

Excluded from re-recording will be those programs for which prohibition exists by reason of production or distribution rights restrictions.

### **Commercial television**

Re-recording or copying from commercial television must follow the "Guidelines for Off-Air Recording of Broadcast Programming for Educational Purposes."
