

Number of Coaches per Sport High School

Numbers-based criteria

The number of coaches for each sport will be based upon the number of participants in that activity. There will be one head coach for the sport and assistant coaches will be added at the following levels.

1 head coach for each activity	
2 assistant at 20 participants	total 2 coaches
1 assistant at 40 participants	total 3 coaches
1 assistant at 60 participants	total 4 coaches
1 assistant at 75 participants	total 5 coaches
1 assistant at 90 participants	total 6 coaches
1 assistant at 105 participants	total 7 coaches

Needs-based criteria

Due to the varied nature of some activities and the conditions beyond the control of the coaching staff, there are some exceptions to the overall numbers-based guidelines. These will be considered needs-based criteria.

1. If an activity offers multiple levels of competition, there will be at least one coach per level: freshman, junior varsity and varsity, even if the numbers do not support the third coaching addition.
2. Cheerleading: 2 coaches to handle the many events and duties involved with a two-season activity.
3. Football: 2 coaches per level of competition: freshman, JV and varsity
4. Wrestling: 2 varsity coaches and one junior varsity coach minimum
5. Baseball/Softball: 1 additional assistant coach for the second separate practice
