

Student Fees, Fines and Charges

Musical instrument rental

- Students who play a school-owned instrument during the entire school year as their major or primary instrument will be charged a rental fee of \$20.00 per semester (\$40.00 per year).
- Students who play a school-owned instrument on a part-time basis, e.g., as a member of jazz band, as a practice instrument at home, or in conjunction with their personal instrument, may be charged a secondary instrument rental fee of \$10.00 per semester (\$20.00 per year). Band director discretion will be exercised, based upon individual situations and circumstances.
- Students who play two school-owned instruments will pay a maximum fee equal to one primary instrument (\$20.00 per semester/\$40.00 per year).
- Rental fees will be deposited into the music department activity account
- Students will be charged a rental fee of \$10.00 per semester (\$20.00 per year) for school owned percussion equipment.
- Parents will be required to pay for all repairs resulting from negligence.
- In addition to the rental fee, parents may be required to pay for normal minor repairs, adjustments, and maintenance to a maximum of \$30.00 per year. Band director discretion will be exercised.
- Arrangements will be made for indigent students who are unable to pay the given fees.
- The amount of rental fees will be periodically reviewed.
