

**Databases** provide you the works cited entry! <sup>(C)</sup> When you copy and paste from a database, check and correct the following:

- italics
- Proper capitalization of titles (and that title is not cut off!)
- No http:// on URLs
  - No hyperlinks (unless your teacher asks for them)
- Punctuation
- MLA date format for ALL dates
  - **o** Day month year
    - 9 Feb. 2019
    - Fall 2020
  - Include all portions of date given, including seasons
- Proper abbreviations
  - o **p. vs. pp.** 
    - p. 7
    - pp. 35-9
    - pp. 124+
  - $\circ$  months
- Jan. Feb. Mar. Apr. Aug. Sept. Oct. Nov. Dec.
- May June July



- For SIRS (Issues Explorer and Discoverer)
  - All of the above AND
  - Proper spelling out of database title, for ex. SIRS Discoverer
  - Full information regarding original container (check actual source)
