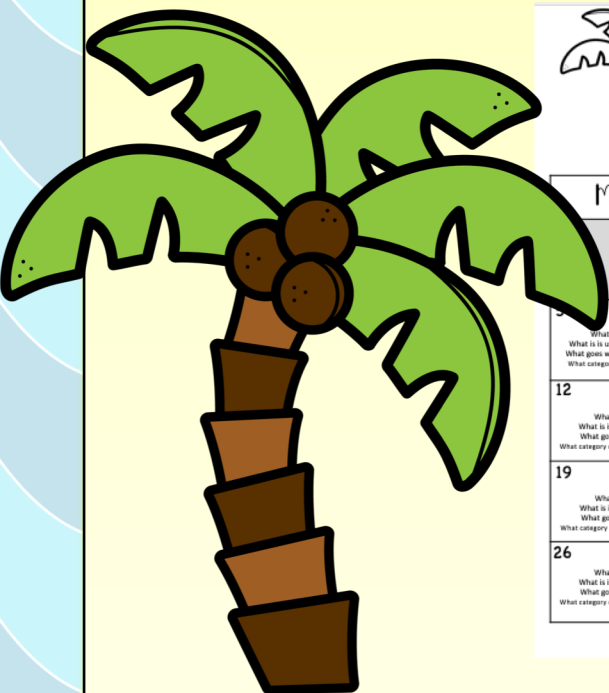

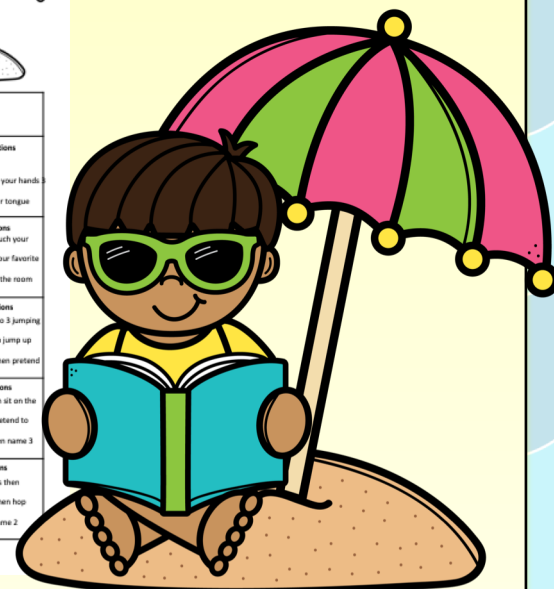

Most importantly, have a happy and safe summer ☺ Enjoy!!

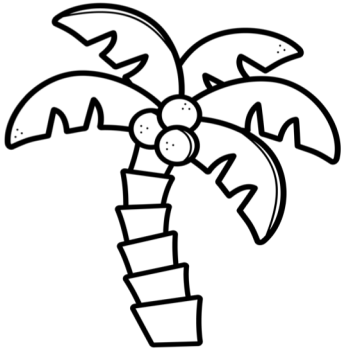
