

SUMMER READING ASSIGNMENTS AT WATAUGA HIGH SCHOOL

The Watauga County Board of Education supports summer English assignments for students taking Honors and Advanced Placement courses.

Watauga High School Honors and Advanced Placement courses are academically rigorous. Students receive added quality point for successful completion of these courses. Students who wish to enroll in English Honors and Advanced Placement courses are advised of requirements for summer reading assignments prior to spring registration.

Students are fully aware of the summer assignments related to the high standards of these courses. Their decision to enroll reflects their commitment to Honors and Advanced Placement course requirements. These reading assignments enhance development of analytical reading, critical thinking, and lifelong learning.

Teachers of Honors and/or Advanced Placement (AP) level classes at Watauga High School may require summer reading/assignments of the students enrolled in those classes. The teacher may determine the appropriate time and means of evaluation of summer assignments.
