Registration is held annually during February & March. Students that turn age 3 or 4 by September 1 may enroll for the next school year. **Spaces are limited.**

Tuition

Age 3 by September 1: \$75 monthly

Age 4 by September 1: \$135 monthly

About Our Program

Special Education

Special education is specially designed instruction, at no cost to the parents, to meet the unique needs of children with disabilities.

The Individualized Education Plan (IEP) team may determine a student needs related services to benefit from his/her early intervention program which may include transportation, speech therapy, physical and occupational therapy, assistive technology, or vision support.

Parents, legal guardians, and educators may refer a child for a screening and/or an evaluation. If it is determined a child has a disability as defined under Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and would benefit from specialized instruction, an IEP is developed and placement is determined.



IEP Referral Process

- The parent or legal guardian may initiate a referral by visiting the preschool page at tooeleschools.org or by phoning our preschool offices at 435-833-1966.
- The preschool team will schedule a screening to identify areas of delay.
- After the screening the team will discuss areas of concern and may discuss additional areas to be assessed.
- After assessments, the team will schedule a day/time to review the results and discuss eligibility for special education with consideration to the following:

- 1) Does the child have a disability as defined under Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)?
- 2) Does the disability adversely affect their education?
- 3) Does the child require specialized instruction in order to access the general education?

- If the team determines the student is eligible, they will develop an IEP.
- Services are provided by appointment and/or in a preschool setting.
