School meal accounts, menus and nutritional information will be housed under one app: Linq Connect. Look for the app online or you can set up your account on their website: <u>https://linqconnect.com/</u>. Your existing account funds transferred over during the summer. Student meal prices for 2023-24 will remain the same, visitors will see a slight increase. Get involved: sign up to volunteer, join your school's PTA or become a business partner. Open House/Walk Through events are July 27-28 and July 31 for elementary and middle schools; some high school welcome events are only for 9th grade/new students. Click the hand for a link to the schedules.



Check your child's **bus stop time** and location for pick up and drop off. Bus Stop Look-Up will be LIVE **July 26**. Click the bus to check your stop/info.

To receive emergency and nonemergency messages from the District via text, please opt in to the message service (School Messenger) by texting the word **SUBSCRIBE** to the number **68453**.



Schools use **Parent Square** for communication from the principal/school. If you have not activated your account, you will receive an email before school starts (note: you will still get emails without activation, but no access to secure documents like report cards and schedules). There is also a ParentSquare app available. CCSD School Police will be installing an Ident-A-Kid visitor management system at all schools to better screen school visitors upon entry.



Class schedules for middle and high school students (and homeroom assignments for elementary students) will be released on **July 26**. Students will receive schedules via student email; parents also will receive an email with this information.



Free/reduced price meals are available for eligible families. One online form can be completed for all children in a family. There are additional benefits, including reduced fees for college entrance exams and other resources. Access the form at <u>https://linqconnect.com/</u> starting mid-July.
