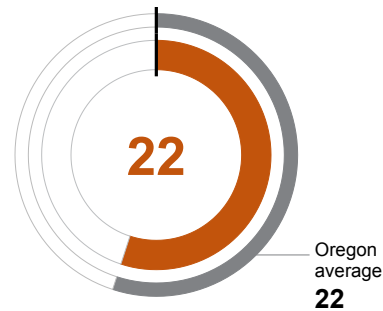

### School Environment

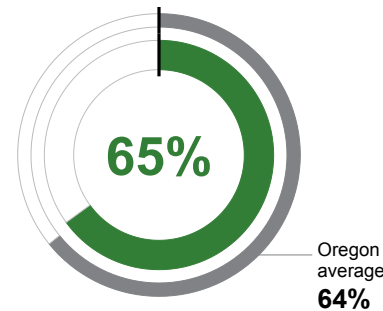
#### CLASS SIZE

#### REGULAR ATTENDERS

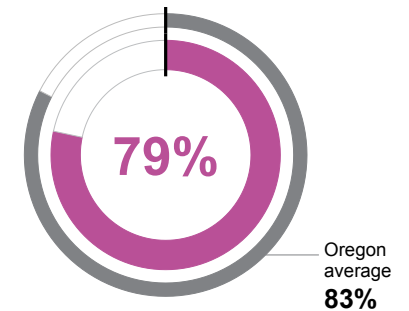
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

#### ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

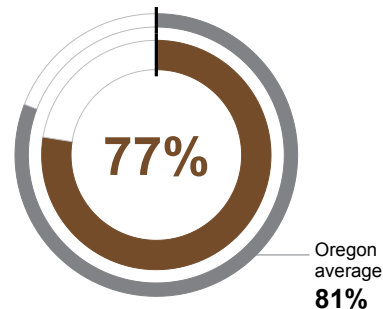
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

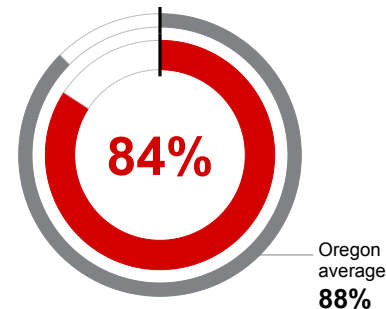
#### ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2017-18 graduating in 2020-21.



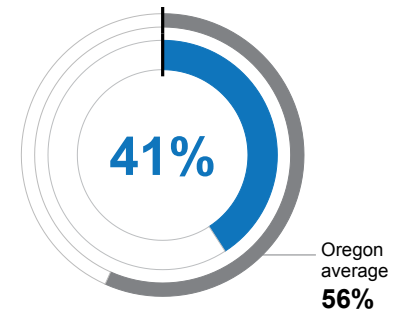
#### FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

### School Goals

The St. Helens School District is committed to providing an environment that is welcoming and inclusive. The District opened a Family Resource Center in the fall of 2021 to welcome new students and to help connect students and their families to supports and services within the District and those provided by our community partners. Family Resource Center staff hosts events and classes for students and parents to promote family engagement, and the center provides a space to learn about and access technology. Bilingual (Spanish) services for students and families are provided.

### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

### Safe & Welcoming Environment

St. Helens High School is committed to providing an environment that is welcoming and inclusive. Our school believes in the motto "Be Here. Be You. Belong." We have established the 9th grade mentoring program, "Lion Crew," and are also developing a Sources of Strength peer mentoring program for students who need additional support.
