


CLASS SIZE






ON-TIME GRADUATION



School Goals

The St. Helens School District is committed to providing an environment that is welcoming and inclusive. The District opened a Family Resource Center in the fall of 2021 to welcome new students and to help connect students and their families to supports and services within the District and those provided by our community partners. 




