## Enrolling in Westport Community Schools Acceptable Proof of Residence

Before any student is enrolled in Westport Community Schools, the student's parent or legal guardian must prove legal residence in the Town of Westport. Families whose primary residence is outside the Town of Westport are not eligible to attend Westport Community Schools. Effective July 1, 2009, all applicants must submit at least three proofs of residency. Documents must be presented at the time of registration. The school district may photocopy these documents for our records, but any photocopies made will not include any financial information, such as bank account, credit account numbers and/or balances, or Social Security numbers.

**YOU MUST PRESENT AT LEAST 3 DOCUMENTS FROM LIST BELOW  
ALONG WITH A CURRENT MASSACHUSETTS LICENCE OR STATE ID**

ACCEPTED FORMS OF PROOF HOMEOWNERS
Utility bill (most current month)
Mortgage bill (most current month)
Real estate tax bill (most current)
Insurance policy (homeowners only)
Vehicle excise tax bill (current year)
Paystub or W2

ACCEPTED FORMS OF PROOF RENTERS
Copy of current lease and a signed Landlord/Tenant Affidavit (Notarized)
Utility bill (most current month)
Insurance policy (renters' policy)
Paystub or W2 with current address
Bank statement with current address
