Lodi Unified School District Textbook and Chromebook Information and Guidelines

Lodi Unified School District takes every precaution to maintain the integrity of the textbooks and Chromebooks that we "loan" to our students. We expect parents and students to help us protect our textbooks and Chromebooks.

Textbooks are issued within the first 10 days of the school year and returned within the last 10 days of ending the school year. Chromebooks are issued to students and are not returned until they are advised to do so. Your child may be issued a hardbound core subject textbook for English, Math, Science, and History (not all subjects/grade levels have a hardbound textbook). Some children may receive textbooks for Intervention and Elective classes as well. All instructional materials are costly, ranging in replacement value from \$53.00 - \$310.00*. Textbooks are considered a "loan" and will be returned at the end of the school year. Chromebooks loaned to students may follow them through their time in Lodi Unified Schools until requested to be returned. If your child loses their textbook and/or Chromebook (or damages the textbook and/or Chromebook beyond repair) you will be responsible for the replacement cost of the items issued to your child.

Your child will receive their own personal workbooks for the subjects mentioned above. The District provides the first workbook at no cost to your child and it does not need to be returned; however, if your child loses their workbook, you will be responsible for the cost of any replacement workbooks. The workbooks range from \$5.00 - \$36.00.

- Student will treat all textbook materials and Chromebooks with respect.
- Student textbook materials and Chromebooks have a barcode that become specific to each student's record.
- Student is responsible for the condition of and the return of their "barcode specific" textbook materials and Chromebook.
- Student upon receiving textbook materials and a Chromebook shall immediately report any "issues" (markings, torn pages, moisture damage, keyboard, and or screen damage) regarding these materials to the school library staff.
- Student should never leave their textbook materials or Chromebook with another student, with a teacher, or leave them unattended.
- Student defacing (removal of barcode, markings, torn pages, moisture damage, keyboard, and or screen damage) of textbook materials and/or Chromebook shall result in a fine and/or cost of the replacement value of the textbook materials and/or Chromebook and will be billed to the student.
- Student shall return their textbook materials on their scheduled return day toward the end of the school year.
- Students with overdue and/or textbook fines and Chromebook fees may result in consequences (i.e., exempt from extra-curricular activities, dances, etc.).

*An optional Care Plan is offered on Chromebooks covering accidental damage. Please see your School Library Staff for additional information and a complete price list of student materials.
