Children in preschool and elementary school are the most likely to get head lice - tiny, wingless parasitic insects that feed on tiny amounts of blood drawn from the scalp of humans.

SIZE COMPARISON

NIT

Tiny eggs are laid at base of hair shaft and are often confused with dandruff.



2

NYMPH

Nits hatch into baby insects and become reddish-brown after feeding on human blood.



3

ADULT

Females can lay up to 100 eggs in their 30 to 45-day life span.

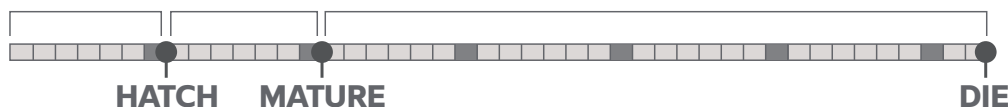
